## Entry Confirmations and Move Ups

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

Deadline for move-ups for Saturday is the Monday preceding the trial.(October 25)  
Moveups must be submitted in writing (e-mail okay), and must be **received** by 12:00 noon, Monday, October 25. Moveups are not official until e-mail confirmation of moveup has been sent.

NOTE – Dogs must jump their indicated height in Preferred classes – they do not have the option of jumping at a higher height. A dog must be entered only in Preferred or only in Regular – entries may not be split between Preferred and Regular for any “set of trials” (weekend)

- The Sno-King Agility Club and Argus Ranch assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone, FAX or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
- Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering a dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete. Dogs wrongly entered may not be transferred to another class after entries close.
- Entry fees will not be refunded **in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date**, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. ## Height Cards

**Exhibitor Information**

- At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat buckle collars, but no hanging tags or attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Food and toys are not permitted on the course area, and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- **All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.**
- These Agility Trials will be held indoors on dirt. We will be running two rings concurrently. Judging will begin with the Excellent standard class. The JWW ring will start when the first group of Excellent Standard has concluded. Standard ring order will be Excellent, Open, Novice. JWW ring order will be Open, Novice, Excellent.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **Due to space limitations, no exercise pens will be allowed in the arena. Please stack crates when possible. Exercise pens may be set up in the heated obedience barn across the driveway from the arena.**
- The health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, judges, and spectators is of paramount importance. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups**

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. **There will be no equipment familiarization at these trials.**

**Directions to the show**

**From I-5 North or South.** Take the Auburn exit (Highway 18) Exit to Auburn-Black Diamond Road eastbound. Turn right immediately onto SE Green Valley Road (just past Neely Mansion). Go approx 7.5 miles. Turn right onto 212<sup>th</sup> Avenue SE (just after the green bridge sitting on dry land on your right). Take first left just after crossing river into Argus. The arena will be on your right.

**From I-405 Southbound.** Go south on Maple Valley Highway (Highway 169), into Black Diamond. Turn right on Roberts Road (look for Coal Car). Go approximately 4 miles. Turn left onto 218<sup>th</sup> Street. At the bottom of the long hill is a stop sign. Go straight across the bridge at the Green River and take the first left into Argus Ranch driveway.
