This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "USDAA". The rules and regulations of the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. as amended January 1, 2004 shall apply at this event. A copy of USDAA rules and regulations may be obtained for \$7.00 (includes S&H) online at www.usdaa.com, USDAA Store. Please do not include with entry fees.

ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE

All entries must be received no later than 5:00 PM, Wednesday, May 11th, 2005. No cancellations or changes are permitted after May 20th.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks. Amounts shall be paid within 30 days of postmarked notice of returned check if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse. No refunds of overpayments for amounts of \$10.00 or less after deduction of service fees.

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor of dog for just cause should the committee view that participation by the competitor of dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the initial closing date and accompanied by the correct fees, as follows:

A registration form is included with this Match Schedule. If your dog is not already registered with USDAA, you must complete and submit this form with your entry. All dogs must be registered with USDAA (registration has a "U" prefix) in order to enter. If your dog's registration card was issued with the "A" prefix, this indicates the dog was not 18 months of age at the time of registration; no additional registration is required as long as the dog is 18 months of age by the event date. CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

NO QUAILFYING SCORES MAY BE EARNED TOWARD TITLES AT THIS EVENT.

CHAMPIONSHIP PROGRAM STANDARD CLASSES

Championship classes are open to dogs not entered in the Performance Program at this event.

This class shall be for all dogs regardless of legs or titles earned. This class will be scored pursuant to Starters/Novice rules.

Following are the jump heights for the Championship Program (Performance Program heights in parentheses):

| <u>Dog Height</u> | <u>Jump Height</u> | <u>Long Jump</u> | <u>Table</u> |

PERFORMANCE PROGRAM STANDARD CLASS

Performance classes are open to dogs who are not entered in the Championship Program classes at this event. This class shall be for all dogs regardless of legs or titles earned and will be run on the same course as the Championship class but require jump heights be set at 8", 12", 16", and 22" instead of 12", 16", 22", & 26", respectively. Also, there are no spread hurdles and the A-frame is lowered to a height of five and one-half feet at the apex. This class will be scored pursuant to Starters/Novice rules.

NON-STANDARD CLASSES – Championship & Performance

These classes are open to all dogs regardless of legs or titles earned.

This non-standard class is scored pursuant to Starters/Novice rules contained in Chapters 6 & 7 of USDAA Rules and Regulations.

Snooker: has an opening sequence of point collection similar to the Gamblers followed by a closing sequence of a set pattern. Roughly parallels the billiards game of "snooker", requiring the dog to successfully complete a 'red' jump prior to attempting an obstacle designated as any other color. This non-standard class is scored pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 6&7 of USDAA Rules and Regs.

Jumpers Class: consists of a course of jumps and may include a tire and tunnels. This class shall be scored "time plus faults".

Prizes and Awards

First through third place in each jump height in each class will receive a placement ribbon.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations, which are hereby incorporated by reference, including, but not limited to, the following rules and conditions for submission and acceptance of entry:

- This test is open to all dogs at least eighteen months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitch in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's ability to perform safely, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.
- All dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete in USDAA sanctioned events. A registration form may be obtained online at www.usdaa.com, or registration may be made concurrently with entry to this show, a form for which is included in this Agility Test Schedule.
- Two rings will run alternately.
- No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration at all times. Handlers through entry at this event accept full responsibility for themselves, their guests and the actions of their dogs.
- No entries shall be accepted, changed, altered, or withdrawn for any reason after the closing date as provided in the section titled "ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE" herein.
- THERE SHALL BE NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. A service fee of \$10.00 shall be deducted from all refunds for reason of overpayment or entries withdrawn before the closing date; hence there are no refunds on balances of \$10.00 or less in over-payments or as a result of cancelled entries. Refunds will be made by check no later than 30 days following the event date.
- DOGS MUST REMAIN ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES, except when competing in the ring or in the warm-up area.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.
- No dogs may be left unattended except when properly kenneled in designated kennel areas. **Redhot Rovers** cannot and do not assume any liability for loss of any items left unattended.
- Dogs must be exercised only in the designated areas. Please pick up after your dog.
- FAULT LIMITS may BE APPLIED in all classes for which faults are assessed. Limits shall be announced during the judge's briefings.
- Competitors may set up on Friday morning at 10:00 AM.
- Check-in shall be between 11:00 AM and Noon.
- ALL COMPETITORS through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video and broadcast rights for this event are the exclusive property of USDAA.
- All tenting and parking will be restricted to designated areas. As with all spectator venues, you are encouraged to present yourself and your dog in the best manner possible, including attire and sportsmanship. Help us to preserve such venues by following all show ground rules. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.
- This event is being held outdoors with limited shade trees near the rings. Please bring adequate shade protection for sun and rain. There are bathroom facilities near the rings.
- Fast food, grocery stores, and restaurants are nearby the show site.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

SITE: Frontier Park is on the west side of Meridian Ave in Graham, WA. The entrance to the park is directly off Meridian St. near the intersection of Meridian and 216th St. E.

FROM I-5 (PORTLAND):

Take I-5 north to highway 512 and go east about 8 miles to Puyallup and exit at South Hill (Meridian St). Take Meridian St. south approx. 7 miles toward Graham. Look for the park on the right.

FROM THE NORTH ON 167:

Take 167 south to highway 512 towards Puyallup. Exit at South Hill and follow Meridian St. South approx 7 miles to Graham. The park is on the right.

GENERAL AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that Redhot Rovers has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee alone shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, of the holding of the event and of the opportunity to have the dog participate and/or to be judged, I (we) agree to hold the organizing committee, Redhot Rovers, United States Dog Agility Association®, Inc., including their members, officers, directors, agents and employees, sponsors of the event, and owners of the premises upon which the event is held and their employees harmless from any claim for loss or injury that may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.
