



DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registrable breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes.

Regular

8 inches	for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
12 inches	for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 inches	for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20 inches	for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 inches	for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

OBSTACLES

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

All Days there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization**

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **12:00 PM Pacific Time on Monday June 6th, 2005**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to r2agility@verizon.net. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial on Sat. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends each day.

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Regular and JWW agility, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, email, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Puyallup Valley Dog Fanciers, Robin Cohen, and R2Agility** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

RING and CRATING INFORMATION

The agility rings are OUTSIDE in the infield grass area behind the grandstands. For those of you that were here in the summer of 2003, this is the same area with all newly planted grass. If you haven't been here before, the area is very limited shade but there is space around the rings for shade canopies.

PARKING

IMPORTANT PARKING INFORMATION

PARKING IS A PRIVILEGE EXTENDED BY THE SHOW GIVING CLUBS. Western Washington Fairgrounds Puyallup, WA

The agility trials will be held outdoors on grass regardless of the weather. Make sure to plan accordingly.

There are fast food restaurants, etc. near the show site. There will also be concession stands near the breed, obedience and agility rings.

See the parking information sheet later in this premium for day and overnight parking information. ALL overnight parking/camping is \$25.00 per night. There will be a \$4.00 charge for day parking at the trial.

Driving Directions to Western Washington Fairgrounds:

From Seattle and the North: Take I-5 S. to the Puyallup Exit #142B in Federal Way. As exiting, stay in the left lane. Turn right at the traffic light at the end of the exit ramp, then turn left at the first traffic light onto Hwy. 161. Travel approximately 8 miles into the Puyallup Valley (Hwy. 161 becomes Meridian St.) Continue through town. The fairgrounds will be on your right at 9th Ave SW

From Olympia and the South: Take I-5 N to exit #127, Hwy 512. Follow 512E. for 10 miles to the Meridian St. S. exit. Turn left under the freeway. The fairgrounds will be on your left.

From Bellevue and the Eastside: Take I-90 to I-405 S. Take exit #2 to Hwy 167 toward Kent/Auburn. Travel south on Hwy 167 approximately 20 miles to Hwy 161 S /Hwy 152 W. Travel 2.3 miles to the second exit, Meridian St. S. At the light at the end of the exit turn right. The fairgrounds are on the left
