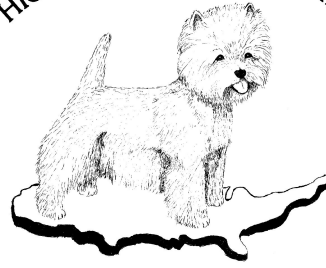


For this trial, **33%** of entries are specified as online entries for the first 48 hours. After that time, the percentage will be adjusted according to the numbers of entries that are available at any given time.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs age 12 months and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register able breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes.

8 inches	for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
12 inches	for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 inches	for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20 inches	for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 inches	for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

OBSTACLES

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

All Days there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization**

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Regular and JWW agility, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION: YOU MAY NOT ENTER THE SAME DOG IN PREFERRED & REGULAR CLASSES IN THE SAME SET OF SHOWS.

PLEASE INCLUDE A COPY OF YOUR JUMP HEIGHT CARD WITH YOUR ENTRY. ALL DOGS (UNLESS JUMPING 24") WITHOUT HEIGHT CARDS WILL HAVE TO BE MEASURED BY THE JUDGE, AKC REP OR MEASURING OFFICIAL.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **12:00 PM PDT on Monday, August 8th, 2005.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to r2agility@verizon.net. No phone move ups accepted.

Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

REFUNDS: A refund of the entry amount, less fees of \$5, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary by **Monday, August 8th, 2005.**

Bitches in season are not allowed in the Agility Trial area.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **West Highland White Terrier Club of America and R2Agility** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

RING and CRATING INFORMATION

There is ample space around the rings for crates and shade canopies. There are no trees on-site, so plan to supply your own shade.

Turn RIGHT onto SE Green Valley Road (just past Neely Mansion). Follow for about 7.5 miles.
Turn RIGHT onto 212th Way SE (Right after Green Bridge sitting on land at right)
Take First LEFT into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

From Hwy. 410 or WA 164 (Auburn-Enumclaw Hwy.)

Turn LEFT onto 244th Ave. SE (approximately one mile out of Buckley)
Go STRAIGHT at Light on SE 436th Way/WA-164. Go STRAIGHT at Stop Sign SE 416th St.
Go STRAIGHT at Stop Sign SE 400th St. Turn LEFT at Stop Sign onto SE 384th St.
Turn RIGHT at Stop Sign 212th WAY SE. Turn RIGHT at ARGUS RANCH Sign (just before Bridge)
