DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

One-half of the entry fees will be refunded upon written request from the exhibitor for bitches who come in season after entries close.

Lynden and Northwest Washington Fairground Facilities

Lynden is a quiet town located just North of Bellingham. It's Dutch heritage was established as settlers from Holland began to arrive in the early 1900s. The results of their hardy work ethic are still seen today in the area's successful dairy and berry farms, plus its well-maintained homes. The city provides full services, food and shops. Many of these are located within an easy walk of the trial site, and camping is available on-site in a park-like setting with water, power and dump station.

Acres of manicured grass for long walks, a large but secluded streamside off-lead play park and ample crating area are a few of the amenities that this trial offers.

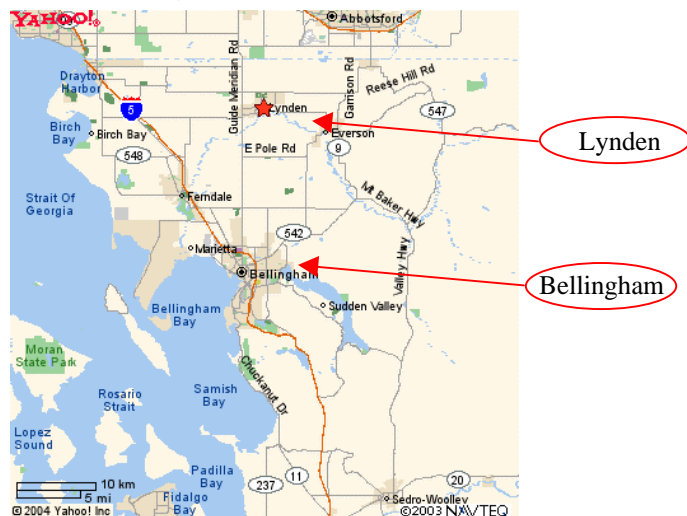

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. **There will be no equipment familiarization at these trials.**

HOSPITALITY INFORMATION

We are not allowed to sell food on the fairgrounds, however, there will be a pot luck lunch available for a small donation and workers receive the expansive buffet lunch each day worked. There are also eating facilities nearby.

The Judge's dinner will be held at C.J. Leghorns at the Homestead Farms Golf Resort about 5 minutes from the fairgrounds. Advance reservations will be required. Please let us know if you are planning to attend through a note with your entry or an e-mail to amy@dentalparts.com. For those staying in an RV at the fairgrounds, let us know if you would like transportation to the dinner and we will arrange it for you.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS – MOVE-UPS – CHECK-IN

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging times will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. Running order will be sent via e-mail or regular mail if no e-mail is available. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, please contact the Trial Secretary.

Deadline for move-ups for Saturday is the Monday preceding the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing (e-mail okay), and must be received by 12:00 noon Monday July 18th. Move-ups are not official until e-mail confirmation of the move-up has been sent to the participant.

There will be no formal check-in. Armbands will be available in binders located in the lunchroom. Someone will be there to help you when you check in. Please remember to check in directly with the Gate Steward. **JUDGING WILL BEGIN AT 8:30 AM BOTH DAYS.**

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW LOCATION

From the North, take I-5 south to exit 270, Birch Bay-Lynden Road, turn east and proceed approximately 8.2 mi. to Hwy 539 (Guide Meridian St.), turn left. Turn right on Front Street.

From the South, take I-5 to Exit #256A onto Hwy 539 (Guide Meridian St. – right turn) and proceed approximately 10 miles to Lynden. Turn right on Front Street.

The Fairgrounds are on the right before the main business district. Enter through Gate #2 and continue all the way back (south) to the horse arena.

Reminder to Canadian exhibitors: the Aldergrove/Lynden border crossing doesn't open until 8:00 A.M.

OBSTACLES AND RING SIZE

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials. These agility trials will be held indoors in an arena with dirt flooring and ring sizes of 85' x 90'. The arena size is 90' x 200'. There is a grandstand area for viewing and a paddock area attached to the arena for crating of dogs. There is a lunch room adjacent to the arena and plenty of room for spectators in the arena bleachers.

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form and confirmation letter carefully and make certain you have entered the correct classes.

NOTE: Do NOT enter a class "higher" than you are eligible for on the assumption you will complete a title before then. "Move-downs" after the closing date for entries are not allowed. Dogs without an AKC Height Card will need to be measured prior to their first run, excluding 24" class dogs unless a VMO or REP is present.

NOTE: A dog must be entered only in Preferred or only in Regular. Entries may not be split between Preferred and Regular for any "set of trials" (weekend).

Prizes and Awards

- First Prize – Blue Rosette
- Second Prize – Red Rosette
- Third Prize – Yellow Rosette
- Fourth Prize – White Rosette
- Qualifying score – Dark Green Rosette

First place dogs in each class and height division will receive a toy. Qualifying score required for all prizes. A special rosette will be given for any dog completing a title at this trial. Double Q ribbons will also be available.

TRIAL REGULATIONS & NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The Trial will be open 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Consult final confirmation for running order of classes and times of judging.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Illegible entry forms will be returned.
- Entry fees will NOT be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or child(ren) create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on trial grounds.
- Aggressive dogs will not be allowed.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area.
- If your dog has an AKC HEIGHT CARD, please include a photocopy with your entry. If you do not include a copy, you will have to show it prior to running your dog. If your dog has not yet received a height card, please indicate on your premium. Your dog will have to be measured by the judge prior to running in its first class, unless it jumps 24" height. To keep things running smoothly, we would like to know in advance, how many dogs need to be measured, so we can plan to allow the time for this.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. We will NOT wait for exhibitors. Judging for the Standard classes will commence at 8:30 AM.
- The Chuckanut Dog Training Association and Northwest Washington Fairgrounds assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardian.
- There is crating space indoors adjacent to the arena.
- PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG.
