ENTRY ACCEPTANCE

Please see Chapter 1, Sections 11 –

Rules & Regulations for valid
acceptance requirements (Effective
07/01/05). Envelopes/ transactions
containing entries for more than the ten
(10) dog maximum shall be treated as
an invalid entry and returned to the
sender. As of 7/1/05, the AKC
requires that if online entries are to
be accepted, a specific percentage
of total entries must be specified as
available from online entries in the
first 48 hours. For this trial, **50%**
of entries are specified as online
entries for the first 48 hours. After
that time, the percentage will be
adjusted according to the numbers
of entries that are available at any
given time.

GENERAL SHOW RULES

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after entries close.

Entries sent by express mailing services MUST have the signature requirements waived. The secretary will not pick up entries being held for signature, and no entries will be considered as being received until they are delivered. Please note the opening time of 8:00 AM on July 5, 2005; no entries will be accepted before that time and date.

Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made. Entry fees must accompany entries.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Entries which are incorrect, illegible, or incomplete will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging times will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

The **CDC** assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

The health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, judges, and spectators is of paramount importance. The trial may be canceled or stopped before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, lightning, extreme heat, hurricanes, floods, or earthquakes, for the well-being of people and dogs.

No grooming or smoking in the agility area.

• **REFUNDS** A refund of entry fees, less AKC recording fees and judges' fees, will be given for any bitch that comes into season after the close of entries provided that the trial secretary is notified before the commencement of judging each day in writing. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds. Except for the above, there shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the Closing Date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

• **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER** This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of breeds that may participate.
