Entry Information

Entry fee (per trial) 20.00 first entry, \$10 for each additional entry per dog. (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee).

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

A refund of one-half the entry fee will be given for bitches who come in season after entries close, provided the request is made in writing before the commencement of judging each day.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

There will be no novice equipment familiarization at these trials.

Move-Ups

Move-Ups after entries close must be submitted, in writing, to the Trial Secretary, by 12 noon PDT, September 12, 2005. Saturday/Sunday moveups will be allowed at this trial.

Hospitality Information

Food will be available for sale on the grounds. Restaurants are also within quick walking distance.

These trials are LIMITED TO 300 RUNS with entries received by First Received. Any entries sent by Fed Ex or special delivery should have the "signature waived" box checked. No hand-delivered entries will be accepted for the first 48 hours of the opening. 150 runs per day will be accepted on line.





1 Go to Dog Events Online: <http://www.DogEventsOnline.com>


