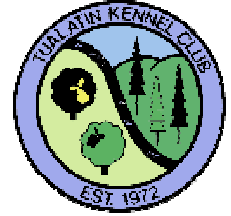

A refund of the entry fee, less the \$3.00 AKC recording fee, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary by Monday, Jan. 16th, 2006. Bitches in season are not allowed in the agility area.

ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

"The Rose City Cluster is accepting online entries through the DogEventsOnline (www.dogeventsonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% Paper entries: 67%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

- 1) include postage or be metered; 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender. 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required"

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Fri-Sat: DFAO will offer 10" Silver Plated Paul Revere bowl for Highest Scoring Dog in Regular Standard and for Highest Scoring Dog in Regular JWW classes as well as a HIT rosette.

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

All dogs receiving their MACH at this trial will receive a MACH bar and ribbon! If you are close, please let the trial secretary know.

JUDGING SCHEDULE: There will be 2 rings (100' x 90') with rubber matting surface. This is the same type of flooring that is used at AKC Nationals in Tampa, FL. Judging will begin at 8:00 AM each day.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register able breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes.

INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

OBSTACLES

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

All Days there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization**

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Regular and JWW agility, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

NOTE: The International Std and Jww classes are open only to dogs that are eligible to compete in BOTH the Excellent Std and Excellent JWW classes.

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION: You may not enter the same dog in preferred & regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please include a copy of your jump height card with your entry. All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge, except 24" unless a VMO or REP is present.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **12:00 PM PDT on Monday Jan. 16th, 2006.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to r2agility@verizon.net. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial Friday and Saturday. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a valid email address is submitted on the entry form, future correspondence concerning the entry may be solely via email.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. A dog can be excused at any time if, in the opinion of the Judge, the dog is out of control or unsafe in its negotiation of the equipment.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site.

We want to retain these facilities for future events.

Remember, all complaints regarding conduct prejudicial to the sport will be dealt with in accordance with AKC rules by the Show Committee.

This includes dogs relieving themselves on the shrubbery outside the show buildings.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 4:00 pm Wednesday, January 18, 2006 (or when building is ready). Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday January 22, 2006.

The agility area will NOT be available for setup until AFTER the rings are set up and the flooring is down.

THERE SHALL BE NO DRILLING NOR INTENSIVE OR CORRECTIVE TRAINING OF DOGS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR PREMISES.

The agility area is available via a side door starting at 6:30 AM on trial days (Friday thru Sunday).

ALL DOGS shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or agility rings.

NO PLAY HUTS OR SIMILAR HOLDING STRUCTURES WILL BE ALLOWED.

All crating must be WITHIN taped and posted areas. Exercise pens will be allowed only if containing multiple dogs. Due to space restriction, the show giving clubs reserve the right to require exhibitors to reduce their crating space.

PARENTS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN.

NO FLEXI LEADS, HALTI-TYPE COLLARS OR PINCH COLLARS IN THE BUILDING.

The show-giving clubs are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.

THE SHOW COMMITTEES will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident of misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these shows.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

NO DOGS wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

The Club(s) reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show – None will be mailed.

RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check & credit card. Subsequent returned checks & credit cards from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the show secretary.

The show giving Club, the show secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, or without the signature of the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form.

GROOMING AREA & GENERAL INFORMATION – JANUARY 2006

OPEN HOURS for grooming areas, halls A,B,C – Wednesday, Jan. 18th, 2006, 4:00 PM – 11 PM. Thursday, Friday, & Saturday grooming areas will open at 6:00 AM & close at 11:00 PM. Sunday, Jan 22, 2006, the grooming area will open at 6:00 AM & close on hour following Best In Show.

HALLS D&E: Main Exhibit Halls will be open at 6:00 AM and will close each day after Best In Show completion of specialty/special events.

THROUGHOUT THE BUILDINGS: All chairs, crates, and accessories must be placed within designated areas and must no block aisles, door exits or fire extinguishers. Flexi-Leads will not be allowed in buildings.

EXHIBIT HALLS (D&E): No grooming. Your crates may be placed in designated areas during the showing of your breed, but must be removed upon completion of your breed judging.

ALL GROOMING AREAS: Rugs and/or matting will not be allowed under crates or pens. Paper or plastic must be used under all pens. Please provide your own paper or plastic. Shavings will be for sale in the D Hall for use on top of paper or plastic.

CRATES: Where possible, crates must be stacked and crates with dogs left in the building overnight clearly marked with name and phone number of person to contact in case of an emergency.

RESERVED GROOMING AREAS: See Reserved Grooming Form for fee, instructions, and information. Reservations for Reserved Grooming will be handled by the Jack Onofrio Dog Shows, L.L.C. Staff.

GROOMING AREA FOR DAY USE ONLY: An area will be provided for DAY USE ONLY

ELECTRIC OUTLETS: are adequately spaced. No extension cords across aisles and no electric space heaters.

DISHWASHING: is not allowed in the restrooms. There will be a dishwashing station provided near the dog wash areas.

DOG WASHING: There will be a dog washing area provided in Hall C and will close at 4:00 PM on Sunday, January 22, 2006.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All parking is a privilege extended by the show-giving clubs & the Portland Exposition Center. They reserve the right to withdraw this privilege from any person who uses abusive language, argues with parking personnel, or attempts to circumvent the rules and regulations. All parking is at your own risk. The show giving clubs & the EXPO center assume no responsibility or liability for damages or loss to any vehicle or its cargo.
- When Expo Parking Lot is full, exhibitors may enter to unload only but then must go park at PIR. All parking at Expo must be in a lined space or you will be ticketed/towed.
- **Dogs are NOT ALLOWED in any landscaped area** at the EXPO Center or the lawn and shrubs in the complex across North Force Ave, or around the sidewalk area on the north side of the Expo Center. Failure to observe the rules may result in an Event Hearing. Outdoor exercise pens will be provided.
- Everyone using this facility is expected to keep & leave the area clean.
- Limited handicap parking (with a valid permit) is available for both the general & reserved parking areas. These spaces will have easy access but may be some distance from the show rings.
- **All overnight parking units must be self-contained. No dumping of gray water or sewage.**
- **There will be no access to ANY building from 11:00 pm until 6:00 am.** See general information for hours individual buildings will be open.
- All vehicles must vacate the premises no later than one hour following Best In Show Sunday, January 22, 2006. No overnight parking on Sunday January 22, 2006.
- All parking fees must be paid in US funds.

LOADING & UNLOADING

- A supervised loading & unloading area close to the grooming area will be available & is accessible from the MAIN GATE ONLY. A time limit per vehicle will be observed to give as many exhibitors as possible access to this area.
- Unloading will begin at 4:00 pm Wednesday, January 18, 2006. Please refer to the grooming information provided in this premium list for further information on access times.

GENERAL PARKING

- General parking is available daily. Enter from the MAIN GATE ONLY. The parking fee is \$7.00 per day or \$6.00 per day for carpools with 3 or more passengers.
