


During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% Paper entries: 67%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

"Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

- 1) include postage or be metered;
- 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender."
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required"

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register able breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes.

Regular

8 inches	for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
12 inches	for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 inches	for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20 inches	for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 inches	for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

OBSTACLES

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

All Days there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization**

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Regular and JWW agility, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION: You may not enter the same dog in preferred & regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please include a copy of your jump height card with your entry. All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge, except 24" unless a VMO or REP is present.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Please be aware that the City of Enumclaw has a "Pit Bull" ordinance which is an absolute ban on any dogs defined as falling in the Pit Bull category. These dogs can be picked up and confiscated by animal control. Since the trial site is within the city limits of Enumclaw, it is not recommended that owners of any pit bull breed enter this event. We have discussed the situation with the city and they have agreed to ask the city council for an exception for future events. Unfortunately, the exception cannot be obtained in time for this year's trial.

Dogs are NOT allowed inside the fenced track area adjacent to the rings. PLEASE make sure to pick up your dog's poop.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Northwest Bearded Collie Club of Puget Sound and R2Agility** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **12:00 PM PDT on Monday, July 10th, 2006.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to r2agility@verizon.net. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

REFUNDS: A refund of the entry amount, less fees of \$5, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary by **Monday, July 10th, 2006.**

Bitches in season are not allowed in the Agility Trial area.

RING and CRATING INFORMATION

There will be ample crating space on the grass around the rings. There is **NO SHADE** at this facility, so bring your shade tents.

Food Information

There are fast food locations and grocery stores in Enumclaw within a few miles of the show site.

Driving Directions to Enumclaw High School

From I-5 South (Seattle): Take Highway 18 (Federal Way area) east about 4 miles to the Auburn-Enumclaw exit (Highway 164). Take 164 southeast toward Enumclaw for about 13 miles to Semanski St. Turn right on Semanski for about a mile to SE 456th St. The High School is on the SouthWest corner of the intersection.

From I-5 North (Portland): Take Highway 512 (South Tacoma) east for about 11 miles toward Puyallup. Past Puyallup, take the SR-167 east exit for ½ mile to the SR-410 east exit. Take SR-410 east for about 14 miles to Enumclaw. Turn left at Semanski St and go for about 1/3 mile to SE 456th St. The High School is on the left.

From SR-169 (Maple Valley): Drive south on SR-169 toward Enumclaw. Just before Enumclaw, turn right (west) on SE 400th St. Drive west for 1.2 miles and turn left on 244th Ave SE. Drive for 3.5 miles south to Warner Ave W (Se 456th St) and turn left. Drive for ½ mile to the High School.

Overnight RV parking will be available at the trial site, but there are no hookups available. There is no charge for RV parking.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
