• **REFUNDS** A refund of entry fees, less AKC recording fees and judges' fees, will be given for any bitch that comes into season after the close of entries provided that the trial secretary is notified before the commencement of judging each day. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds. Except for the above, there shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the Closing Date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

• **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER** This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

GENERAL SHOW RULES

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after entries close.

Entries sent by express mailing services MUST have the signature requirements waived. The secretary will not pick up entries being held for signature, and no entries will be considered as being received until they are delivered. Please note the opening time of 8:00 AM on July 5, 2006; no entries will be accepted before that time and date.

Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made. Entry fees must accompany entries.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Entries which are incorrect, illegible, or incomplete will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging times will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

The CDC assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

The health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, judges, and spectators is of paramount importance. The trial may be canceled or stopped before completion in the case of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, lightning, extreme heat, hurricanes, floods, or earthquakes, for the well-being of people and dogs.

No grooming or smoking in the agility area.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. We will NOT wait for exhibitors, except for pre-arranged changes due to conflict. **Entry Confirmations and approximate check-in times will be sent to the EMAIL address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.** Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a stamped, self-addressed postcard with entry. Email inquires preferred.

METHOD OF ENTRY • DOG EVENTS ONLINE

Please see Chapter 1, Sections 11 –16 of the American Kennel Club Agility Rules & Regulations for valid acceptance requirements (Effective 07/01/05). Method of entry "First received". Envelopes/transactions: Containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry. Express mail must be designated "no signature required". The CDC is accepting online entries through the above system. During the first 48 hours after opening the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper entries will be as follows: 40% online and 60% paper entries. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the Club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
