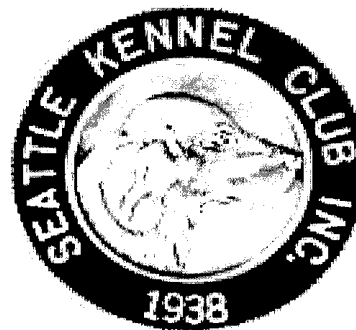



"SKC is accepting online entries through the DogEventsOnline (www.dogeventsonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% Paper entries: 67%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

- 1) include postage or be metered;
- 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required"

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of **15 months** (note new age as of Sept. 1, 2006) that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register- able breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judge's only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial who do not possess an official height card. Note highlighted changes effective 9/1/06.

8 inches for dogs **11 inches** and under at the withers
12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. *All Days* there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization, as of 9/1/06, AKC does not allow it.**

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Regular and JWW agility, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION: You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please include a copy of your jump height card with your entry. All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge, **except 24"/26"** unless a VMO or REP is present.

RING and CRATING INFORMATION

There is crating space in the building adjacent to the ring.

Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. We will NOT wait for exhibitors, except for pre-arranged changes due to conflict. **Entry Confirmations and approximate check-in times will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show**, contact the Trial Secretary. Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a stamped, self-addressed postcard with entry.

The show site will be available to exhibitors 3PM to 10PM Friday, March 9, 2007. Doors are locked at 10PM. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging Sunday, March 11, 2007.

Each entry will receive two (2) Identification/Admission wristbands per dog entered with their acknowledgement. Wristbands are good for each day that dog is entered. To gain admittance for each day into the show building, each person MUST wear their ID or pay admission. Absolutely NO EXCEPTIONS.

No baby strollers or wheeled child carriers allowed in the building.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the show grounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent. Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Seattle Kennel Club and Robin Cohen** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
