A refund of the 1/2 the entry amount will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification is provided to the Trial Secretary before the commencement of the trial.

Bitches in season are not allowed on the Trial grounds.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

All dogs receiving their MACH at this trial will receive a MACH bar and ribbon! If you are close, please let the trial secretary know.

JUDGING SCHEDULE: Two rings 100'x120' Outdoors on grass. Judging will begin at 8:00 AM each day and rings will run alternately, with one judge. The schedule of classes will be Excellent Std, Novice JWW, Open Std, Excellent JWW, Novice Std, Open JWW, Excellent FAST, Open FAST, Novice FAST. The start time and class schedule is subject to change depending on entry numbers. A final schedule will be included with your confirmation.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registrable breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

All Days there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization**

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted in writing so that the Trial Secretary receives them by **12:00 Noon PDT on Monday March 26th, 2007**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via postal mail, or email to agimals@juno.com. If you do not receive a prompt acknowledgement of your move-up request, please contact the Trial Secretary to make sure that it was received. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends each day.

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Standard agility, JWW and FAST, including the Preferred Classes, will be offered on Friday and Saturday. All levels of Standard agility and JWW, including the Preferred Classes, will be offered on Sunday; FAST is NOT offered on Sunday. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s). **If you have questions about which class to enter, please contact the Trial Secretary before the closing date. All dogs entering FAST must start at the Novice level, regardless of their level in other agility classes.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. **Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement attached, are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee, except for bitches in season as specified on page 2. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address given on the AKC entry form after the closing date. If the exhibitor provides an e-mail address, it is assumed that the exhibitor can receive e-mail with attachments from the Trial Secretary, and confirmation will be sent by e-mail; please make sure your spam blocker is set to accept messages from agimals@juno.com. If an e-mail address is not provided or if postal mail is specifically requested, confirmation of entry will be sent by postal mail. If an exhibitor has not received a confirmation and schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Ephrata-Moses Lake Kennel Club, Wenatchee Kennel Club, and the Trial Secretary** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

LOCATION FOR TRIAL

Grant County Fairgrounds Moses Lake, WA

The agility trials will be held outdoors on grass. We will have plenty of room for crating, but shade is very limited and there is no shade around the rings. There will be plenty of room for shade tents and canopies. Be prepared for wind! This time of year, eastern Washington’s weather can be variable....

There are fast food restaurants, etc. within a few miles of the show site. There will also be concession stands near the rings as the **Spring Fair will be going on at the same time as the trial.**

See the parking information sheet later in this premium for day and overnight parking information. ALL reserved overnight parking/camping is \$25.00 per night (\$65 3 night package deal). There may be a \$3.00 charge for day parking at the trial.

Driving Directions to Grant County Fairgrounds

From I-90 Eastbound: Take I-90 to Exit 176 onto W. Broadway Ave. Go NE on Broadway approx. 2.8 miles to the intersection of W. Broadway and N. Stratford/S. Alder (the street names are different on the left and right side of W. Broadway). Turn left (north) onto N. Stratford and proceed across the bridge to W. Valley Rd and turn left. Go approx 1.3 miles to the fairgrounds entrance.

From I-90 Westbound: Take I-90 to Exit 179 and exit to Highway 17 North. Follow 17 North around the top of the lake to Grape Dr NE (about 5 miles) and turn left onto Grape Dr NE. Grape Dr. NE is the first major intersection after the Highway 17/N. Stratford intersection. Follow Grape Dr NE south to W. Valley Rd and turn right. The fairgrounds is about 1/3 mile on the right.

Entrance to Fairgrounds

Use the BLUE gate entrance in the Blue Parking Lot. This is the lot just outside the fence to the East of the agility area. It is also just south of the outdoor Rodeo Arena. The gate will open at 2:00 PM on Thursday, March 29th, 2007. It will close at 10:00 PM each day. It will re-open at 6:00 AM each day.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
