ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

"AMSC is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% Paper entries: 67%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

- 1) include postage or be metered;
- 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) **Express mail must be designated "no signature required"**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of **15 months** that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judge's only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial who do not possess an official height card.

8 inches	for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
12 inches	for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 inches	for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20 inches	for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 inches	for dogs over 22 inches at the withers
26 inches	Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. *All Days* there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Standard and JWW agility (no FAST), including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class.

The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION: You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please include a copy of your jump height card with your entry. All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge, **except 24"/26"** unless a VMO or REP is present.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **American Miniature Schnauzer Club** assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, Jan. 14th, 2008.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to r2agility@verizon.net. No phone move ups accepted.

REFUNDS: A refund of the entry amount, less fees of \$10, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary by **Monday, Jan. 14th, 2008.**

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 4:00 pm Wednesday, January 16, 2008 (or when building is ready).

The agility area will NOT be available for setup until AFTER the rings are set up and the flooring is down.

THERE SHALL BE NO DRILLING NOR INTENSIVE OR CORRECTIVE TRAINING OF DOGS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR PREMISES.

ALL DOGS shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or agility rings.

CRATING INFORMATION

The following is the General Crating information for the Rose City Cluster – Agility Area. These rules will be in effect for the Miniature Schnauzer agility trial as well. Please be aware that people will be setting up for the 4 day agility show on the Thursday during the Miniature Schnauzer show. After the conclusion of the Schnauzer show, those people not entered in the agility trials on Friday-Monday will need to move their crating setup to the general Conformation/Obedience crating areas.

The trial committees will be working very hard to make the most space available to the agility competitors. However, due to the available crating space, they will be enforcing the following agility area crating area rules. Please work with your fellow competitors to compact space as much as possible. If we all work together, we'll have enough space for everybody's dogs.

- No Mats will be allowed in the agility crating areas.
- No un-stackable soft crates
- No X-Pens or play huts.
- No chairs allowed in the crating area.
- No un-entered dogs allowed in the agility area.

PARKING INFORMATION

The parking (day and overnight) will be handled by the Rose City Cluster parking rules and officials. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
