FROM I-5 NORTH OR SOUTHBOUND – Take exit 306B to get to the east side reserved/general parking entrance or take exit 307 Marine Dr. West to get to the Force Ave west side reserved parking entrance or to circle around the Expo to get to the exhibitor express entrance.

Judge: Kera Holm

Height Order: Small to Tall

Measurements: If you have not been measured or shown a height card, you must do so before you run. The gate sheets will be highlighted to indicate if you need to have your dog measured or show its card.

The AKC is placing increased emphasis on the trial secretaries seeing your height card for EVERY trial. It doesn't matter if we've seen it last week. Your confirmation will clearly state in black background lettering if we need to see your height card. Some of you have emailed/faxed us height card information and we will update our lists next week. Please make sure to give yourself enough time to show us your card at checkin.

Start Times: **First dog on the line:** 4:00 PM. Check-in at 3:00 PM. Crating space available when the rings are put down or after 2:00 PM.

Class Schedule: **We will be running ALL standard, and then ALL Jumpers**
Ring 1 - Exc Std, Open Std, Nov Std
Ring 2 - Exc Jww, Open Jww, Nov Jww

Walkthroughs: There will be a single walkthrough for each class.

Moveups: The deadline for moveups is Monday Jan. 19th, 2008, at 6PM. Moveups must be received in writing or email by that deadline.

Setup: The agility area is being prepared on Thursday morning. We anticipate that the area will be available for setup after 2PM, but don't have a firm time yet.

If you setup early and we need to move your stuff, we will. We plan on being there early on Thursday afternoon and will coordinate setup at that time.

Crating: As indicated in the premium, there will be NO X-Pens, NO chairs, and NO "camps" allowed in the crating area. We have 311 dogs entered in the show over the 4 days and will all need to work together to fit into the limited crating area. If you have multiple dogs, you must plan on stacking your crates at least 2 high. If you have only 1 dog, you are not expected to stack crates.
