Entry Information

Entry Fees: \$22.00 1st entry, and \$12.00 2nd/3rd entry (incl. AKC recording fees of \$3/\$3/\$3), same dog/day.

Closing: Closes January 18, 2008, 6:00pm. Unlimited entry.

Catalog: \$10.00 - please pre-order catalogs using entry form - limited number available at the trial.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded, first through fourth place in each height division, in each class.

Regular & Preferred classes:

- 1st place, blue ribbon
- 2nd place, red ribbon
- 3rd place, yellow ribbon
- 4th place, white ribbon
- Qualifying score, dark green ribbon

All first placements will receive a toy (approx. value \$1-\$3)

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

All teams completing a MACH or PAX at these trials will receive a ribbon, as well as a jump bar. **If you and your dog are close, please let a member of the trial committee know.**

All Breed High in Trial

Custom embroidered folding chairs will be given out for High in Trial for runs on Saturday only, which will be awarded Sunday morning in the general briefing. The highest combined score from two clean rounds, for all dogs entered in the show, for both small (8", 12" & 16") and large (20", 24" & 26") dogs in the regular classes, will win. Scores of 100 in both classes is required to be in contention. Scoring is based on the highest combined YPS.

High Scoring Doberman

The highest scoring Doberman in the standard class and JWW class will win an engraved plate, which will be awarded Sunday morning in the general briefing. Scores of 100 are required to be in contention. Scoring is based on the highest YPS. An award will be given for high Doberman in standard and high Doberman in JWW.

Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of a class. A warm-up area (indoors), consisting of a regulation agility jump (one per ring), will be provided.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Height Divisions

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all regular classes:

8"	for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class:	4"
12"	for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class:	8"
16"	for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class:	12"
20"	for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	Preferred class:	16"
24"	for dogs over 22 inches at the withers	Preferred class:	20"
26"	<i>dogs may be entered at this height at owner's discretion</i>	Preferred class:	N/A

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all international classes (if offered):

14"	for dogs 13-3/4 inches and under at the withers (mini dogs)
18"	for dogs 16-7/8 inches and under at the withers (midi dogs)
26"	for dogs over 16-7/8 inches at the withers (maxi dogs)

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. There will be no equipment familiarization at this trial. As of 9/1/06 AKC does not allow it.

Move-ups

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing (mail or email) by **6:00pm, Pacific time, Monday, January 28, 2008**. Requests for move-ups over the phone **will not be accepted**.

Day-to-day move ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted on the provided move-up forms, to the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes after completion of the last class of the day. Incomplete information will result in no move-up, so please verify with the secretary that your move-up information is complete.

Classes Offered

All levels of regular and JWW, including the preferred classes, will be offered. FAST will be offered on Saturday only. (International sweepstakes classes will be offered when indicated in the premium and on the entry form). A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class.** The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

Preferred Class Information

You may not enter the same dog in preferred & regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

Jump Height Information

Please include a copy of your jump height card with your entry, whether or not you have previously submitted one. All entries must include a copy of your dog's height card. All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge, except 24"/26" dogs, unless a VMO or AKC Representative is present.

Important Information for Exhibitors

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.

100% of entry fees will be refunded if a **written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date.** After closing, refunds will be given, **if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial,** less all fees, for injured or ill handlers, injured or ill dogs, or bitches in season. **No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial.** Verification from a doctor or vet may be required at the club's discretion. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and a schedule of judging will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. **Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.**

The Mt. Hood Doberman Pinscher Club assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs while on the show grounds and at the motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

Ring & Crating Information

There is an abundance of crating space around the rings on all sides, on concrete. There is no heating in the building, and portable propane heaters are not allowed in the building. Please plan accordingly as it can be cold in February in the Portland/Vancouver area.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all REGULAR titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the PREFERRED classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete at a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
