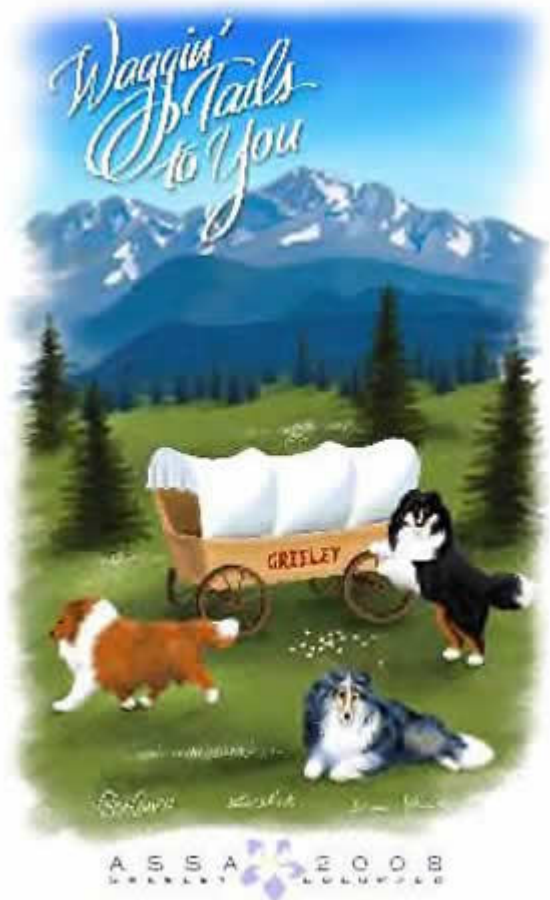

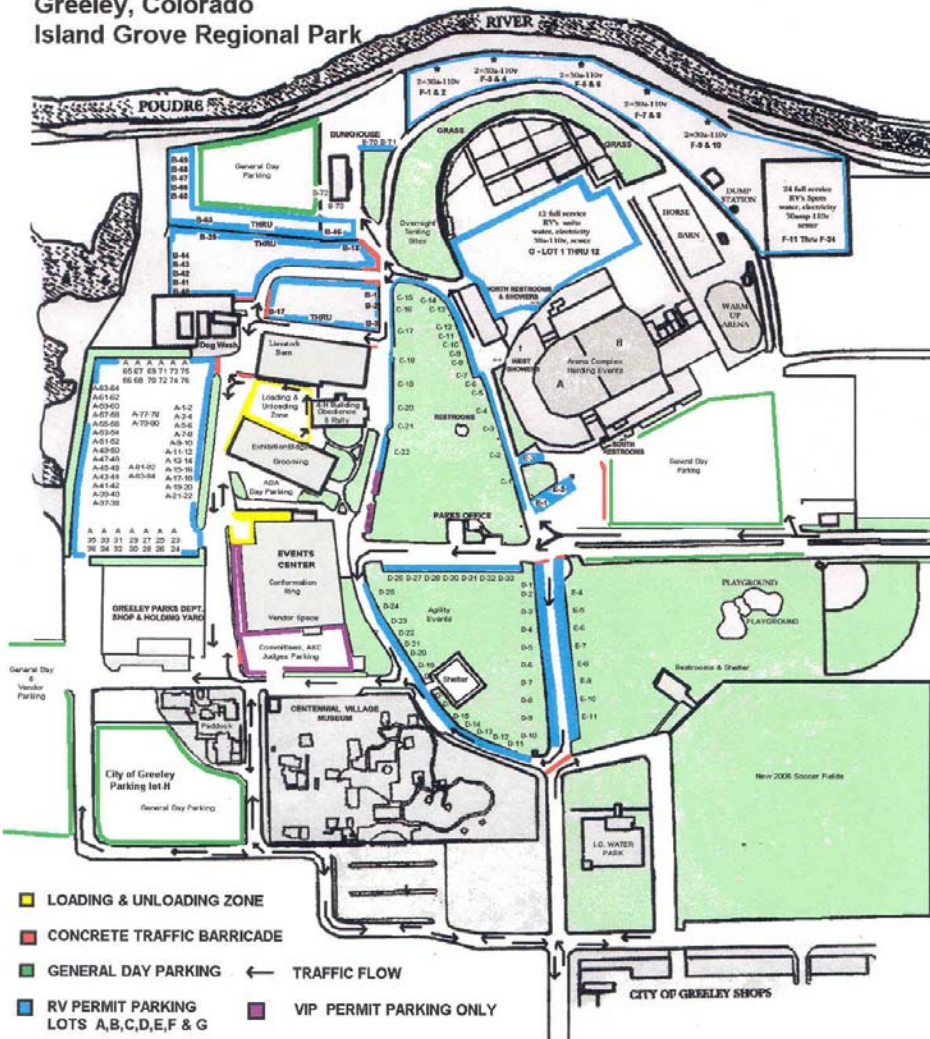

When you enter or register for any event at this show or are on the defined show grounds of the fairgrounds or any of the performance trial venues, including the host hotels and parking areas, you automatically agree to the following rules that have been established for the benefit and pleasant enjoyment of the event by all parties:

1. No puppies under six months of age are allowed in any area of the hotels or events grounds
2. No grooming or bathing of dogs in hotel rooms. There will be bathing facilities at the show site
3. No un-entered dogs in the show area
4. No breeding of dogs or whelping of bitches at the show site or hotel
5. No dogs left in exercise pens overnight
6. For sale signs are prohibited
7. One dog per crate
8. All crates must be stackable. No soft-sided crates permitted at the conformation site
9. Plastic sheeting must be under all crates in hotel rooms
10. Dogs must be crated whenever left unattended in hotel rooms
11. Dogs must be kept on lead at all times when walking in hotel, grounds or show site
12. Exercise dogs in designated areas ONLY; and PLEASE clean up after your dog
13. No exercise pens permitted in grass areas of hotels
14. Flash photography is not permitted ringside
15. Cell phones must be turned off or on vibrate at ringsides. Please leave the area to use your cell phone
16. No smoking indoors or within 25 feet of any performance trial ring or doors
17. No tripods located ringside
18. No saving seats at ringside

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to acceptance. Telephone, telegraph, incomplete or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC herding entry forms or photo copies of the official AKC herding entry form without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC herding entry form cannot be accepted. The American Shetland Sheepdog Club of America, Inc. assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information provided by the owner or the owner's agent on the entry form. **ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED, CANCELLED, ALTERED OR SUBSTITUTED AFTER ENTRIES HAVE CLOSED,**except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Regulations for Herding Tests and Trials.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge or barred from participation by the Trial Committee. If it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Entries will not be accepted without entry fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check from the same exhibitor and may result in the exhibitor's entries being accepted on a cash only basis.

The American Shetland Sheepdog Club of America, Inc. and Island Grove Regional Park assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their dogs on leash (except when in the arena or stock dogs when working) and under control at all times. Exhibitors MUST clean up after their dogs. We would like to be able to use this facility for future test/trials.

Notice to all Exhibitors

- The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are able to perform all obstacles safely. Ring size will be 100 x 100
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries must be on Official AKC Entry forms or photocopy with agreement and rules on back.
- Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.
- Owners are responsible for all errors on entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund or entry fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made.
- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.
- We ask for the cooperation of exhibitors in helping to keep the location as clean as possible in order for us to retain the use of the facility in the future.
- A return check fee of \$25.00 will be added for each check returned. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in entries only being accepted on a C.O.D. basis.

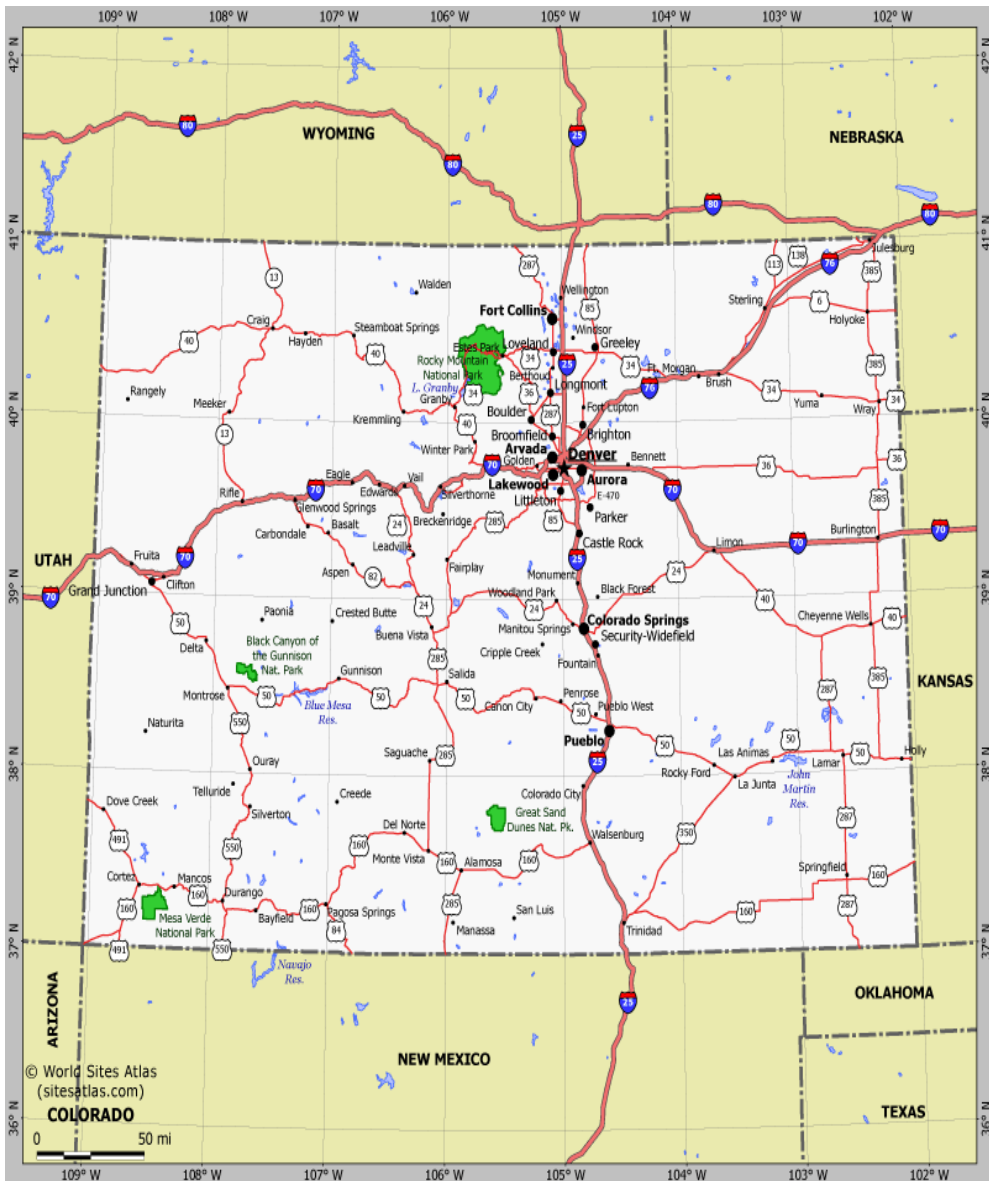

- 3 pt.—place 1-4 in a class
- 4 pt.—RW, Winners, BOB, BOS, AOM

Obedience or Rally

- 1 pt.—participation
- 2 pt.— Qualifying Novice Score
- 3 pt.—Qualifying Open/Advanced Score
- 4 pt.— Qualifying Utility/Excellent Score

Agility/ Herding

- 1 pt.— participation 1 pt.—Participation
- 2 pt.—Qualifying Novice Score 2 pt.—Qualified HT/PT
- 3 pt.—Qualifying Open Score 3 pt.—Qualified HS/HI
- 4 pt.—Qualifying Excellent Score 4 pt.—Qualified HA

BONUS 1 pt for a dog who competes in all five venues

Dogs receiving qualifying scores in performance events will be awarded 2, 3, or 4 points as appropriate for their class, but do not receive the participation point as well. The participation point in performance events is awarded only if the dog competes but does not qualify in the event. Dogs competing in multiple classes at the same event will be credited with the highest placement received in any one class only.

Dogs who make a cut or earn placements and awards in breed competition will be awarded 2, 3, or 4 points as applicable to the award, but do not receive the participation point as well. Dogs who make multiple cuts in a class will receive the same two points as dogs who make one cut. Dogs excused from the breed ring shall still be awarded a point for participation. Dogs disqualified from the breed ring shall not be awarded a point for participation. In the event of a tie, event scores shall be used to break the tie. The dog with the highest total score will receive the award.

The official catalog markings taken from the judges' books for each event shall be used to determine eligibility, participation, placements and official scores.
