Entry fee (per trial) 16.00 per class per dog. (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee each class)

Package price of \$75 if entering all classes all days.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

A refund of one-half the entry fee will be given for bitches who come in season after entries close, provided the request is made in writing before the commencement of judging each day. No refunds will be given for amounts under \$10.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

AKC no longer allows novice equipment familiarization.

Move-Ups

Move-Ups after entries close must be submitted, in writing, to the Trial Secretary, by 6 pm PDT, April 28, 2008. Day to day moveups will be allowed at this trial. Moveups must be turned in within 30 minutes of completion of judging on Saturday.

Hospitality Information

There will be coffee and breakfast items for exhibitors each morning. Lunch will be provided for workers at the trial. There will be no food vendors at the trial. The closest fast food is in Black Diamond, Enumclaw, or Auburn.

General Show Rules

- The Sno-King Agility Club and Argus Ranch assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone, FAX or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
- Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering a dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete. Dogs incorrectly entered may not be transferred to another class after entries close.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.
- Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. ***If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.***
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Exhibitor Information

- ***All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.***
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure dogs are free from parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- These Agility Trials will be held outdoors on grass, weather permitting. We will be running two rings run simultaneously. Judging will begin at 8:00 a.m. with the Excellent JWW class

AGILITY CLASSES

Please see the AKC regulations for agility trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular classes or Preferred classes, with no crossover allowed between them at the same set of trials (weekend.)

Height Cards

All dogs not having a permanent height card must be measured by the judge of record at the show. **If you have a permanent height card, please enclose a copy of your card with your entry form.** You are **still** required to bring your height card with you to the show and have it available to show if requested.

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials.

Judges and Scheduling

- **Saturday** – Novice and Open FAST and all JWW will be judged by Deborah Funk
 - Excellent FAST and all Standard will be judged by Susan McClair
- **Sunday** – Susan McClair will judge all JWW classes
 - Deborah Funk will judge all standard classes.

There will be no FAST classes offered on Sunday

Classes offered and limits

Entries will be limited to 660 total runs per day; 330 per judge.

Classes offered include:

- Standard – Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B
- Standard Preferred – Novice, Open, Excellent A & B
- Jumpers with Weaves – Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B
- Jumpers with Weaves Preferred – Novice, Open, Excellent A & B
- FAST – Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B (Saturday only)
- FAST Preferred – Novice A & B, Excellent A & B (Saturday only)

Height Divisions

Regular classes

- 8 inches - For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
- 12 inches - For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
- 16 inches - For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
- 20 inches - For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
- 24 inches - For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.
- 26 inches – Handler's option

Preferred Classes:

- 4 Inches: For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.
- 8 Inches: For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.
- 12 Inches: For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.
- 16 Inches: For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
- 20 Inches: For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.

NOTE – Dogs must jump their indicated height in Preferred classes – they do not have the option of jumping at a higher height.

Prize And Award Information

- First Prize - Blue Rosette
- Second Prize - Red Rosette
- Third Prize - Yellow Rosette
- Fourth Prize - White Rosette
- Qualifying Score - Dark Green Rosette

A special rosette will be given for any dog completing a title at this trial. A special rosette and a jump bar will be given for any dog completing a MACH or a PAX title
Qualifying Score required for all prizes.

Directions to the show

From I-5 North or South. Take the Auburn exit (Highway 18) Exit to Auburn-Black Diamond Road eastbound. Turn right immediately onto SE Green Valley Road (just past Neely Mansion). Go approx 7.5 miles. Turn right onto 212th Avenue SE (just after the green bridge sitting on dry land on your right). Take first left just after crossing river into Argus. The arena will be straight ahead.

From I-405 Southbound. Go south on Maple Valley Highway (Highway 169), into Black Diamond. Turn right on Roberts Road (look for Coal Car). Go approximately 4 miles. Turn left onto 218th Street. At the bottom of the long hill is a stop sign. Go straight across the bridge at the Green River and take the first left into Argus Ranch driveway.

If you do not check your e-mail or have a spam filter that will reject e-mail from the trial secretary, please do not put an e-mail address on your entry form. All communication from the trial secretary, including acknowledgements of entry, running order, schedules, final confirmation, etc., will be sent by e-mail only, unless you indicate you want it sent by regular mail.

Please check your entry over carefully before mailing. We have had a number of entries recently that were missing important information, like the dog's name, the classes desired or the dog's height.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

*AKC is now requiring that a copy of the dog's height card be submitted with **each** entry for **each** trial. Please help make things go smoother by stapling a copy of the **dog's height card** (the card only – not the entire letter from AKC!) to the back of your entry when sending it to the trial secretary. We will have an AKC rep present at the trial in case anyone needs to have a dog measured for a permanent height card.*

Any dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge or the rep before they can run at the trial.

Earn the eternal gratitude of your trial secretary:

- Make sure your entry is clear and legible.
- Make sure all information (including breeder, sire and dam, if known) is included.
- Staple a copy of the height card (card only—not the entire letter or a copy on a 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper) to the back of the entry
- Don't staple your check or your volunteer form to your entry.

I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this Agility Trial has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Agility Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show, obedience or agility trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto; and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.  Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; they must be measured by a Judge of Record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back to back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
