**ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS**

"The WSSCA is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline ([www.r2agilityonline.com](http://www.r2agilityonline.com)) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% Paper entries: 67%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

- 1) include postage or be metered;
- 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) **Express mail must be designated "no signature required"**

**AWARDS:** Fancy Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for First through Fourth place in each height division in each class.

**Regular Classes** First Place: Blue Second Place: Red Third Place: Yellow Fourth Place: White Qualifying Score: Dark Green

**First Place awards: Fleece Tug**

Welsh Springer Spaniels earning a Qualifying Score earn a Fleece Tug.

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

*All dogs receiving their MACH at this trial will receive a MACH bar and Rosette! Dogs receiving their PAX at this trial will receive a commemorative Rosette. If you are close to either title, please let the trial secretary know.*

### **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of **15 months** that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained ILP/PAL numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

### **HEIGHT DIVISION**

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judge's only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial who do not possess an official height card.

#### **Regular**

8 inches for dogs **11 inches** and under at the withers  
12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers  
16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers  
20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers  
24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers  
**26 inches Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion**

**OBSTACLES:** Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. *All Days* there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

**CLASSES OFFERED:** All levels of Standard, JWW, and FAST agility, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

**PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION:** You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

**JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION:** Please include a copy of your jump height card with your entry. All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge, **except 24"/26"** unless a VMO or REP is present.

### **RING and CRATING INFORMATION**

We are indoors at Argus. The crating is limited in the main building, so please squeeze in as tightly as possible. Please no x-pens, try to stack crates where possible, and "be small" ☺

### **Food Information**

There are fast food locations and grocery stores in Enumclaw, Black Diamond, and Maple Valley within 10 miles of the site. Worker food/snacks are planned for the show as well.

### **Workers Information**

We will use the white board to sign up on the day of the trial.

**MOVE-UPS:** Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, Oct 27<sup>th</sup>, 2008**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to [r2agility@verizon.net](mailto:r2agility@verizon.net). No phone move ups accepted. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

**REFUNDS:** A refund of the entry amount, less fees of \$12 per day, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first class.

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS**

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. **Entry Confirmations and approximate check-in times will be sent to the address or email address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show**, contact the Trial Secretary.

Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a stamped, self-addressed postcard with entry.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable**.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Welsh Springer Spaniel Club of America, Inc., the Pacific Northwest Welsh Springer Spaniel Club** assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

**All dogs** must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

**The safety of dogs is of primary concern.** By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.**

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

**OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

Turn RIGHT onto SE Green Valley Road (just past Neely Mansion). Follow for about 7.5 miles.

Turn RIGHT onto 212th Way SE (Right after Green Bridge sitting on land at right)

Take First LEFT into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

#### **From Hwy. 410 or WA 164 (Auburn-Enumclaw Hwy.)**

Turn LEFT onto 244th Ave. SE (approximately one mile out of Buckley)

Go STRAIGHT at Light on SE 436th Way/WA-164. Go STRAIGHT at Stop Sign SE 416th St.

Go STRAIGHT at Stop Sign SE 400th St. Turn LEFT at Stop Sign onto SE 384th St.

Turn RIGHT at Stop Sign 212th WAY SE. Turn RIGHT at ARGUS RANCH Sign (just before Bridge)

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
