ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

"The WWA is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% Paper entries: 67%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

- 1) include postage or be metered;
- 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) **Express mail must be designated "no signature required"**

AWARDS: Rosette Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and ribbons for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular Classes First Place: Blue Second Place: Red Third Place: Yellow Fourth Place: White Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

A MACH Ribbon and MACH Bar will be given for any new MACH dog! Let us know if you are close.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of **15 months** that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained ILP/PAL numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judge's only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial who do not possess an official height card.

8 inches for dogs **11 inches** and under at the withers
 12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
 16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
 20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
 24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. *All Days* there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

CLASSES OFFERED: Friday – Excellent Standard, Jumpers with Weaves & Fast, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. Saturday and Sunday – All levels of Standard, and Jumpers, including the Preferred Classes will be offered (no Fast on the weekend). A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION: You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please include a copy of your jump height card with your entry. All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge, **except 24"/26"** unless a VMO or REP is present.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Western Washington Hound Association and/or Sammamish Kennel Club** assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, August 17th, 2009.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to r2agility@verizon.net. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

REFUNDS: A refund of the entry amount, less fees of \$10, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial.

Bitches in season are not allowed in the Agility Trial area.

RING and CRATING INFORMATION

There will be ample crating space on the grass around the rings. There is **NO SHADE** at this facility, so bring your shade tents.

Food Information

There are no food vendors scheduled to be onsite at the agility area. However, there will be a few food vendors near the breed rings and there is a Subway sandwich shop by the baseball fields off the main park entrance. There are many fast food places, restaurants, and grocery stores in Redmond within a couple of miles of the park.

Parking Information

Parking for these shows is limited to the marked areas only. For agility, the parking will be on soccer fields 7,8,9. There is **absolutely NO** event parking permitted in the general Marymoor parking lots.

AGILITY PARKING AND CAMPING RESERVATIONS

Exhibitors' parking will be allowed only in SKC/WWHA designated areas as required by King County Marymoor Park.

All **agility** parking (overnight and day) **MUST** be on the soccer fields #7,8,9 near the agility rings. There will be absolutely no agility or dog show parking allowed in the general Marymoor Park parking lots. Failure to follow the show committee instructions regarding parking could result in a committee hearing and/or towing of your vehicle.

AGILITY PARKING RULES

For General Dog Show Parking see the Conformation Premium

On site parking is a privilege extended by the Western Washington Hound Association and reserve the right to withhold this privilege from any person who does not observe the rules and/or instructions of Parking Personnel on duty. Abusive language and other tactics will not be allowed and anyone unable to abide by the rules will be escorted off the premises without recourse or refund of fees. Anyone blocking the fire lanes, illegally parking in handicapped parking, driving/parking inside the show limits or tying up the load/unload zone will pay a fine of \$100.00 and will be towed away at the owner's expense and risk.

- The Load/Unload Zone has a 15-MINUTE LIMIT. PLEASE OBSERVE!
- Handicapped parkers must have and display a current/valid state handicapped permit or vehicular license plate. We have limited handicapped parking and the loading zone CANNOT be used as an alternative.
- There are NO HOOK-UPS for overnighters. There will be NO discharge of any liquid on the grounds. Violation will cause immediate ejection from the grounds with no recourse or compensation.
- GENERATOR EXHAUST MUST BE PROPERLY VENTILATED

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Should the on-site veterinarian determine that any dog enclosed in a vehicle is in danger, the Sammamish Kennel Club and Western Washington Hound Association reserves the right to break into that vehicle. Anyone parking in the show site parking areas must accept full responsibility for damages should this occur.

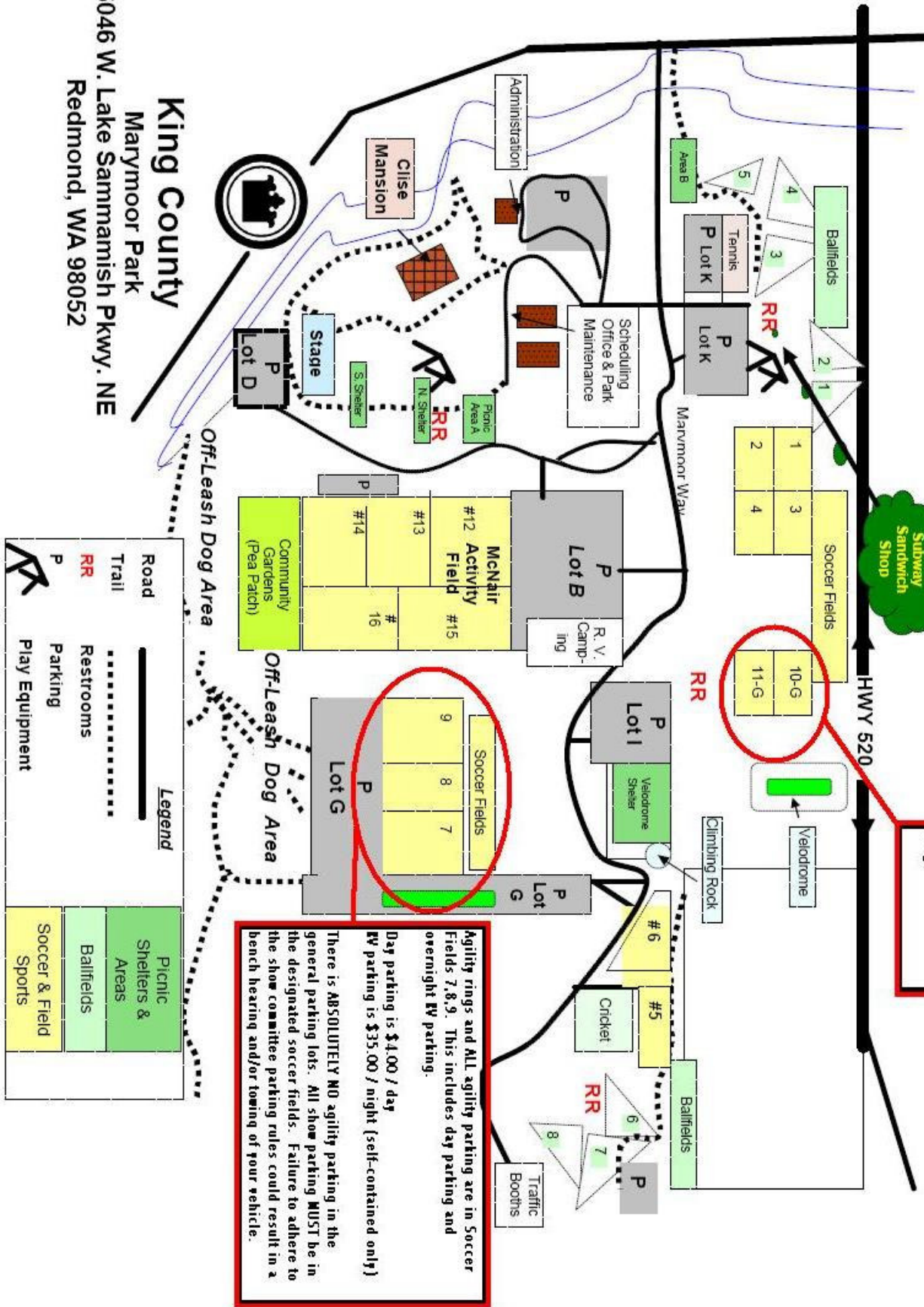

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
