Dogs eligible to enter: This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register able breeds that have obtained (purebred alternative listing, effective 2/1/08) PAL/ILP numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Catalog: \$10.00 Please pre-order catalogs using check box on entry form. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the show.

Refunds: A refund of one-half the entry fees will be given for any bitch that comes into season after the close of entries, provided that the trial secretary is notified before the commencement of judging each day. Except for the above, there shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. **Bitches in season are not allowed in the Agility Trial area.**

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and ribbons for first through fourth place in each height division in each class. Each exhibitor will receive a small gift (\$1.50 in value) of appreciation.

First Place: Blue **Second Place:** Red **Third Place:** Yellow **Fourth Place:** White **Qualifying Score:** Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show. Pins will also be available for titles received at the trial.

A MACH / PAX Ribbon and a MACH / PAX Bar will be given for any new MACH / PAX dog! Please let me know before the trial if you are close.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PST on Monday, March 9th, 2009**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to trowbridge1@charter.net. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. The equipment for this event is provided by K-9 Sports. Information on equipment rental can be obtained by contacting Lori at Lori@k-9sports.com or (503) 632-2227.

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Standard and JWW agility, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site www.akc.org. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes except for move-ups or spelling corrections after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s). You must check your confirmation and report corrections to the Trial Secretary as soon as possible.

You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

RING AND CRATING INFORMATION: There will be inside crating areas available on a first come first serve basis. There is also ample space for crating around the rings. There is limited shade so plan accordingly.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS:

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms, without the agreement attached are not acceptable.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the email address or street address if there is no email address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the how, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial Site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary
