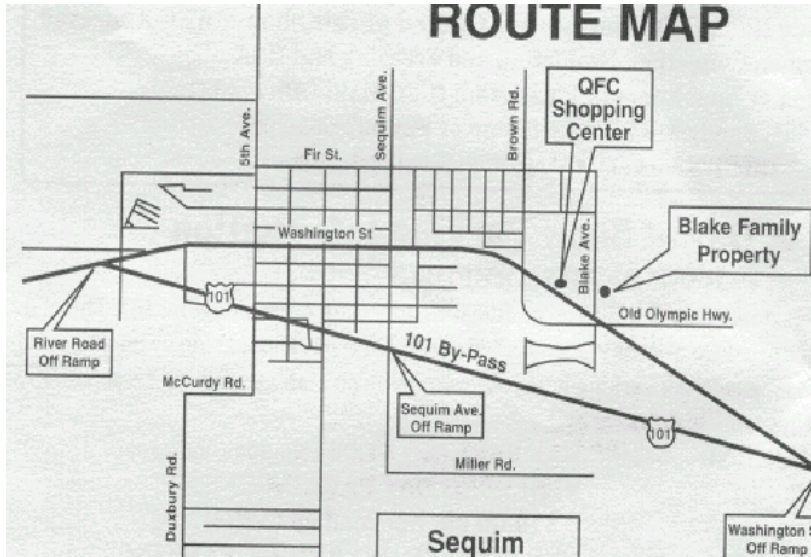

Directions to Veterinarian: Continue down Washington St. through the town until you get to Hooker Road. There is a Chevron station on the left. Turn left at the signal and turn left again at the Hot Shots Espresso Stand. (Valley Center Place) Country Care Vet is on your left.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Exhibitor Information

- This trial is held outdoors on grass. Ring sizes are: 100 x 100
- We will have food available on the grounds. There are fast food places close by also.
- **WORKER'S AWARDS: ALL EXHIBITORS THAT WORK A FULL CLASS WILL RECEIVE \$5.00 FOR EACH CLASS THEY WORK.** Lunch will not be free for workers, but you can make money to pay for it .
- There is little or no shade at the site area, but plenty of room for shade tents on the premises.
- PLEASE NOTE: The water outlet on the grounds is not marked for drinking.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes may walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Entry Information:

Move-Ups after entries close must be submitted, in writing, to the Trial secretary by 6:00 pm Monday, May 25, 2009. Dog's registered name & call name, breed, AKC reg. #, title completed and date, class currently entered, new class requested, owner's name and date. E-mail move-ups will only be official after e-mail confirmation of move-up is sent.

Move-ups for the trial will be allowed provided the above information is given to the secretary before the close of each day's trial.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after entries close. (Except for move-up provisions as specified above.)

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Entries which are incorrect, illegible, or incomplete will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules attached, are not acceptable. E-mail entries will not be accepted. If you send an entry in Fed X or overnight mail, **PLEASE check the "NO SIGNATURE" box.**

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form (e-mail or snail mail) after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

Entry Fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee.

Height Divisions: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Dogs with AKC height cards will not need to be measured if the card is presented at the time of measuring.

HRKC is accepting online entries through the [R2AgilityOnline system](http://R2AgilityOnline.system).

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 45% online and 55% paper entries. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

1. Include postage or be metered;
2. Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including, but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
3. Express mail must be designated "no signature required."

Height Card Information

If your dog has an AKC HEIGHT CARD, **please attach a photocopy with your entry.**

If you do not include a copy, you will have to show it prior to running your dog. If your dog has not yet received a height card, your dog will have to be measured by the judge prior to running in it's first class. To keep things running smoothly, we would like to know in advance, how many dogs need to be measured, so we can plan to allow the time for it.

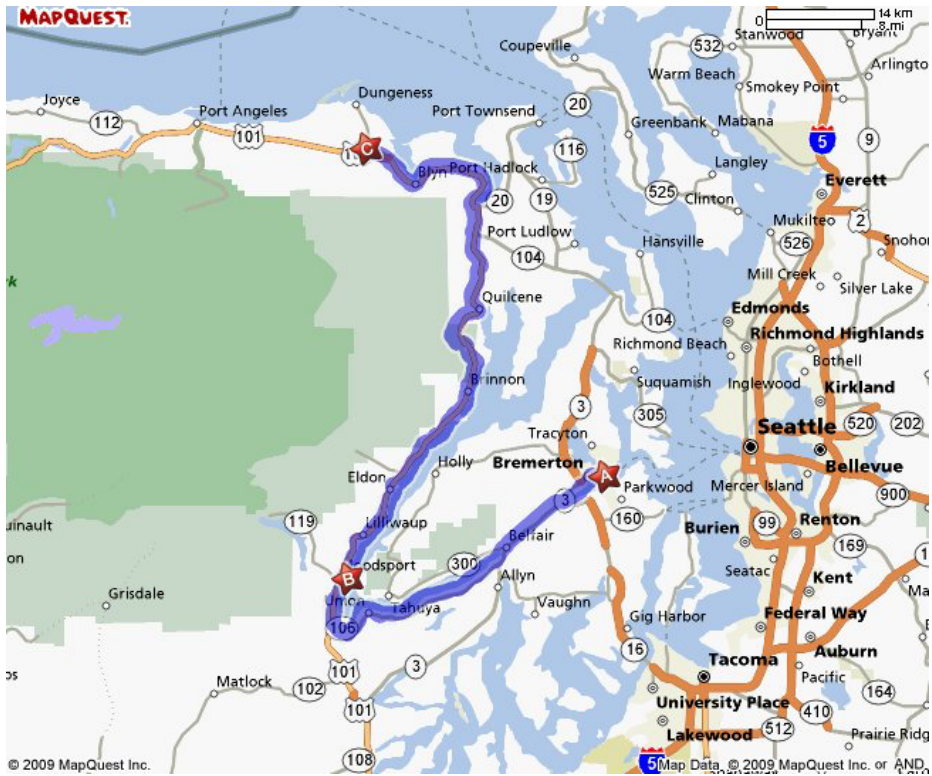

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.
