Rules Applying to Dog Shows
Effective January1, 2010

Chapter 11, Section 1

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class, unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

Hotels

Motels will accept dogs in rooms only if dogs are crated when left alone. Please do not leave motel rooms or grounds without cleaning up all your litter. Any infractions to the above will be reported to the ASSA and the American Kennel Club.

Host Hotel: There is no official "host hotel" for the 2010 National. Exhibitors will be responsible for negotiating their own room rates. Reservations can be made as early in advance as the motels will accept them. Booking via the internet is one of the best ways to get a good rate.

The list below does not include all Tucson motels. However, all those listed are within 2 miles of the show site.

Hotel Arizona is just a couple of minutes walk from the show site and will be venue for the Banquet. Hotel Arizona does NOT provide a shuttle from the airport and recommends Arizona Stagecoach who will provide a door-to-door drop off service for \$36.00.

Notice to dog owners/exhibitors :

When you sign the show entry form, you automatically agree to the following terms concerning motels. They have been established for the good of all exhibitors and will ensure future use of these facilities.

1. All motels accepting dogs require plastic under crates – no exceptions. Plastic sheeting is to be placed under each crate in each room.
2. Dogs must be crated when left alone in the room – no exceptions.
3. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times while in the motel, lobby or on motel grounds. Rooms and lobbies must be kept clean of dog debris.
4. Dogs should be exercised in designated areas on the motel premises. Every dog owner is expected to pick up after their own dog and dispose of waste in designated receptacles. It is the responsibility of the dog owners to find out from the motel staff where these areas and receptacles are located.
5. No dogs may be bathed in the motel rooms. Bathing facilities are available at the show site.
6. Rooms will be inspected daily by members of the motel staff and observed violations or damages will be reported to the motel management and/or the show committee.
7. The show committee, working with a fair and equitable system, is charged with investigating complaints.
8. Each dog owner/exhibitor is expected to cooperate with the investigative committee if a complaint is filed.
9. Flash photography is not permitted ringside.
10. Cell phones must be turned off or on vibrate at ringsides. Please leave area to use cell phone.
11. No smoking indoors or within 25 feet of any performance trial ring or doors.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS



The AKC will collect a \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee for each entry of a dog in all AKC licensed and member dog shows, obedience trials, and tracking tests. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Event/Recording Fees will be collected on each entry.

- **Please note: Rally is considered a separate trial from obedience.**
- At every licensed or member club Rally Trial, a Recording Fee of \$3.00 shall be required for the entry of each dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).
- A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for the AKC.
- **Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. Accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.**
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or agents of Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of dogs in the judging rings.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, E-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The club and/or its Superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **Responsibility for completeness of any entry rests solely with entrant.**
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund or entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for duplicate entries or overpayments. The Superintendent/Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the show, NO REFUND will be made.
- **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.** The Superintendent/Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- **Refunds** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellation made prior to entries closing will be mailed to said exhibitor or agent after the show.
- **Entries will be acknowledged** after entries close with entry acknowledgement and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgement within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Secretary at (360) 681-5055 or E-mail: heelin@earthlink.net.
- **Loss or Damage:** The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

Best All Around Sheltie

To be eligible for this award, dogs must compete in three of five events. Advance registration is required. Entry should be made on the separate registration form for this competition. This form is available in the Bulletin Board, in the Herding and Agility premium lists and on the website.

BONUS 1 pt for a dog who competes in all five venues

Dogs receiving qualifying scores in performance events will be awarded 2, 3, or 4 points as appropriate for their class, but do not receive the participation point as well. The participation point in performance events is awarded only if the dog competes but does not qualify in the event. Dogs competing in multiple classes at the same event will be credited with the highest placement received in any one class only.

Dogs who make a cut or earn placements and awards in breed competition will be awarded 2, 3, or 4 points as applicable to the award, but do not receive the participation point as well. Dogs who make multiple cuts in a class will receive the same two points as dogs who make one cut. Dogs excused from the breed ring shall still be awarded a point for participation. Dogs disqualified from the breed ring shall not be awarded a point for participation. In the event of a tie, event scores shall be used to break the tie. The dog with the highest total score will receive the award.

The official catalog markings taken from the judges' books for each event shall be used to determine eligibility, participation, placements and official scores.

Ribbons: Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dogs in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog receiving a qualifying score. There will be MACH and Double Q Ribbons for Excellent B exhibitors who qualify for them.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded to 1st through 4th places in the Standard and JWW classes (including Preferred) as follows:

1st Place through 4th place ASSA Engraved Silver plates in graduated sizes.

Rosettes and trophies will be awarded to the High Scoring Novice Dog, High Scoring Open Dog and High Scoring Excellent Dog. Method for determining High Scoring Dogs for each class will be from the regular STANDARD class only. (**Preferred classes not eligible**).

Trophies for each of the High Scoring Dogs..... Silver Platter

- High Score in each of the classes is first determined by score and then the fastest yards per second in the Standard run
- For the purpose of this award, the Novice A & B will be considered one class. Excellent A & B will be considered one class.
- All runs must be qualifying runs.

- The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are able to perform all obstacles safely. Ring size will be 100 x 100. Agility will be held outdoors on...grass....
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries must be on Official AKC Entry forms or photocopy with agreement and rules on back.
- Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.
- Owners are responsible for all errors on entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund or entry fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made.
- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.
- We ask for the cooperation of exhibitors in helping to keep the location as clean as possible in order for us to retain the use of the facility in the future.
- A return check fee of \$25.00 will be added for each check returned. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in entries only being accepted on a C.O.D. basis.
- No refund for duplication of entries.
- Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authority, building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulation will be subject to towing at owners expense.
- Dogs under six months of age are prohibited at AKC events.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must include postage or be metered. Must be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including, but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

This trial is open to **Shetland Sheepdogs only** over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC ILP/ PAL numbers. Bitches in season may not compete. No refund for bitches in season.

Handlers in each class may walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided.

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, provided that the request is made in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than Monday, March 8, 2010 before 6:00 pm.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers may opt to run at a higher division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper height division will be eliminated.
