Entries open Monday, January 4, 2010 at 8:00 a.m. & close on Friday, February 12, 2010 at 5 p.m.

Friday night is limited to 150 runs. Saturday and Sunday are limited to 330 runs. Electronic timing will be used.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of **15 months** that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

A refund of one-half the entry fees will be given for bitches that come in season after entries close, provided the request is made in writing before the commencement of judging each day. No other refunds will be given after closing.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. No umbrellas are allowed during walk-throughs. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. ***There will be no equipment familiarization at these trials.***

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent to the e-mail address or regular address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. Class run order will be sent via e-mail or regular mail if no e-mail is available. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, please contact the Trial Secretary.

PLEASE: make sure agilgolden@comcast.net is allowed by your spam blocker. We will not resend or do any extra work to get your ISP to allow us to send messages to your email address!

OBSTACLES AND RING SIZE

All obstacles shall meet the specifications as outlined in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials. These agility trials will be held indoors in an arena with dirt flooring and ring sizes of 85' x 95'. The arena size is 95' wide x 200' long. There is a grandstand area for viewing and a paddock area attached to the arena for crating of dogs. The lunch room is adjacent to the arena. Sorry, no dogs allowed on the grounds unless they are competing.

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form and confirmation letter carefully and make certain you have entered the correct classes. NOTE: Do NOT enter a class "higher" than you are eligible for on the assumption you will complete a title before this trial. "Move-downs" after the closing date for entries are not allowed. *If this is your first entry in Preferred class you must start in the Novice class!* A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC website at www.akc.org.

NOTE: A dog must be entered only in Preferred or only in Regular. Entries may not be split between Preferred and Regular for any "set of trials" (weekend).

Dogs without an **AKC Height Card** will need to be measured prior to their first run, The Judge will begin measuring at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.

MOVE-UPS – CHECK-IN

Deadline for move-ups for these trials is Monday, February 22, 2010 at 6 p.m. PST. Move-ups must be submitted in writing (e-mail okay). Move-ups are not official until e-mail confirmation of the move-up has been sent to the participant. Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday move-ups will be allowed.

There will be no formal check-in. **Armbands will be available in binders located in the lunchroom.** Please remember to check in directly with the Gate Steward before your runs.

JUDGING WILL BEGIN AT: 5:30 PM on FRIDAY with STANDARD, 8:00 AM on SATURDAY & SUNDAY. We will be running two rings ALTERNATELY.

This judging schedule is subject to change. Changes will be noted in the final confirmation letter. PLEASE CHECK THEN!

HOSPITALITY INFORMATION

Lunch will be available for workers. Workers will receive a sticker from the Chief Ring Steward. Food remaining after the workers have eaten will be available by donation on Saturday and Sunday. Food on Friday night will be free for volunteers and available by donation to others after the workers have eaten. There are also eating facilities nearby. Sorry, we are not allowed to sell food on the fairgrounds.

There will be a Judge's dinner on Saturday night after all runs are complete. Details will be available when final confirmations are sent.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW LOCATION - 1775 Front St., Lynden

From the NorthWest, take I-5 south to exit 270, Birch Bay-Lynden Road, turn east and proceed approximately 8.2 mi. to Hwy 539 (Guide Meridian St.), turn left. Turn right on Front Street.

From the NorthEast, take Hwy 11 to Sumas, then R on Halverstick, Follow signs for Everson and Lynden. Continue on Hwy 546 (E. Badger Way) to Guide Meridian Rd. Turn L. Turn L. on Front St.

From the South, take I-5 to Exit #256A onto Hwy 539 (Guide Meridian St. – right turn) and proceed approximately 10 miles to Lynden. Turn right on Front Street.

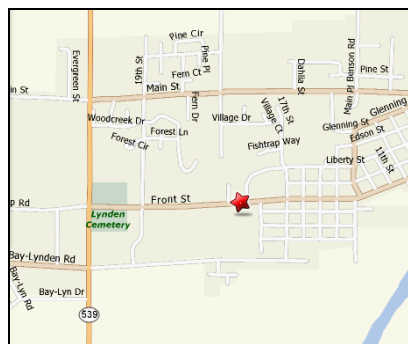
The Fairgrounds are on the right before the main business district. Enter through Gate #2 and continue all the way back (south) to the horse arena. Check in is in the west part of the building.

OVERNIGHT PARKING

Overnight parking is available on the site. A fee of \$17.00 per night is charged. Electric and water hookup is included in this fee. PLEASE SEND FORM ON PAGE 7 OF THIS PREMIUM ALONG WITH PAYMENT. The maps on this page will give you some idea of the relationship of Lynden to Ferndale and Bellingham and shows the location of the fairgrounds in Lynden.

Reminder to Canadian exhibitors:

- **Aldergrove/Lynden border crossing doesn't open until 8:00 A.M.! Use Pacific Highway crossings from the West or Sumas from the East as they are open 24 hrs. if you need to be at the Fairgrounds for the first morning classes. Also, be aware that the Olympic Games are on in Vancouver, Richmond, and Whistler, so traffic may be a bit higher than usual.**



LYNDEN AND NORTHWEST WASHINGTON FAIRGROUND FACILITIES

Lynden is a quiet town located just North of Bellingham. Its Dutch heritage was established as settlers from Holland began to arrive in the early 1900s. The results of their hardy work ethic are still seen today in the area's successful dairy and berry farms, plus its well-maintained homes. The city provides full services, food and shops. Many of these are located within an easy walk of the trial site, and camping is available on-site in a park-like setting with water, power and dump station.

Acres of manicured grass for long walks, a large but secluded streamside off-lead play park and ample crating area are a few of the amenities that this trial site offers.

TRIAL REGULATIONS & NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The Trial will be open Friday from 4:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. and Sat./Sun. from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. **Consult final confirmation for order of classes and times of judging.**
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. **Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms and/or without the agreement and rules that accompany the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable.**
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. Checks will not be deposited until the trial closes.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Illegible entry forms will be returned.
- **Entry fees will NOT be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee.**
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or child(ren) create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Head halters, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on trial grounds. Body harnesses are OK.
- Aggressive dogs will not be allowed.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area. Leashes may not have anything attached to them or dangling from them. Painted or stitched designs or information on collars can be only the dog's name and/or identifying information.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. We will NOT wait for exhibitors. Judging on **Friday for Standard class will begin at 5:30 PM.** Judging for the classes on **Saturday and Sunday will commence at 8:00 AM.**
- The Chuckanut Dog Training Association, Inc., The Northwest Washington Fairgrounds, and Marian Snapp, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardian.
- There is crating space indoors adjacent to the arena and there are heated bathrooms in the facility along with showers.
- PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG(S). Failure to do so will be considered a benchable offense.

Volunteer draws will be made after each day is complete. This is in addition to the other random draws on Saturday and Sunday.

HEIGHT CARD REGULATIONS BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2010

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?

If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date: One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy and check "My dog has a Temporary Jump Height Form" box, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date: A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a Permanent Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement: If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Request Perm" box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a Permanent Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

What if my dog measures into a different jump height then what he is entered?

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement?

Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process once after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.)

What is the jump height card challenge process?

The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge measurements are required. If both challenge measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class.

Until such time that you have received all required challenge measurements, you must continue to compete at the original jump height stated on the permanent jump height card that is in your possession.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.
