Entry Information

Entry fee (per trial) \$15.00 per class per dog (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee each class).

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP, PAL or Pet Partner number, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

A refund of one-half the entry fee will be given for bitches who come in season after entries close, provided the request is made in writing before the commencement of judging each day. No refunds will be given for amounts under \$10.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Move-Ups

Move-Ups after entries close must be submitted, in writing, to the Trial Secretary, by 6 pm PDT, May 3, 2010. Day to day moveups will be allowed at this trial. Moveups must be turned in within 30 minutes of completion of judging.

Hospitality Information

We will have a food vendor at the trial. Sno-King will provide light breakfast and snack food only. The food vendor will accept worker's coupons and cash. They offer a varied menu including vegetarian options, drinks and chips. Workers coupons will be accepted by all vendors at the trial.

General Show Rules

- The Sno-King Agility Club and Argus Ranch assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone, FAX or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
- Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering a dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete. Dogs incorrectly entered may not be transferred to another class after entries close.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.
- Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the e-mail address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. *If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary. If you need a snail-mailed confirmation, please let us know.*
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Exhibitor Information

- *All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.*
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure dogs are free from parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- These Agility Trials will be held indoors on dirt. We will be running two rings run simultaneously.

AGILITY CLASSES

Please see the AKC regulations for agility trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular classes or Preferred classes, with no crossover allowed between them at the same set of trials (weekend.)

Height Cards

All dogs not having a permanent height card must be measured by the judge of record at the show. Height cards are no longer required to be attached to the entry form, but be sure you check on your entry if you have a height card.

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials.

Judges and Scheduling

Friday – All classes will be judged by Deidre Crofton (Excellent only)

Saturday – All JWW will be judged by Deidre Crofton, All Standard will be judged by Tim Pinneri.

Sunday – All JWW will be judged by Tim Pinneri, all Standard will be judged by Deidre Crofton

There will be no FAST classes offered at this trial.

Classes offered and limits

Friday entries will be limited to Excellent only and will be limited to 275 runs

Saturday and Sunday entries will be limited to 550 total runs per day. Classes offered include:

- Standard – Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B
- Standard Preferred – Novice, Open, Excellent A & B
- Jumpers with Weaves – Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B
- Jumpers with Weaves Preferred – Novice, Open, Excellent A & B

Height Divisions

Regular classes

- 8 inches - For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
- 12 inches - For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
- 16 inches - For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
- 20 inches - For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
- 24 inches - For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.
- 26 inches – Handler's option

Preferred Classes:

- 4 Inches: For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.
- 8 Inches: For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.
- 12 Inches: For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.
- 16 Inches: For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
- 20 Inches: For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.

NOTE – Dogs must jump their indicated height in Preferred classes – they do not have the option of jumping at a higher height.

Prize And Award Information

- First Prize - Blue Rosette Second Prize - Red Rosette
- Third Prize - Yellow Rosette Fourth Prize - White Rosette
- Qualifying Score - Dark Green Rosette

A special rosette will be given for any dog completing a title at this trial. A special rosette and a jump bar will be given for any dog completing a MACH or a PAX title

Qualifying Score required for all prizes.

NOTE TO EXHIBITORS:

Please set your spam filter to accept entries from windgold@verizon.net. The trial secretary **will not** go through the steps to be added to your "approved list".

If you do not check your e-mail or have a spam filter that will reject e-mail from the trial secretary, please do not put an e-mail address on your entry form. All communication from the trial secretary, including acknowledgements of entry, running order, schedules, final confirmation, etc., will be sent by e-mail only, unless you indicate you want it sent by regular mail.

Please check off on your entry form if your dog has a height card.

Any dogs without height cards will have to be measured before they can run at the trial. Height cards no longer have to be submitted with the entry form (Thank goodness!)

Earn the eternal gratitude of your trial secretary:

- Make sure your entry is clear and legible.
- Make sure all information (including breeder, sire and dam, if known) is included.
- Don't staple your check to your entry.
- Check over your entry before mailing to make sure it is complete and legible.
- Mail to Trial Secretary's complete address – I've had several lately where the house number was left off. Our mail person is good, and entries usually get here anyway, but let's not tempt fate!

Vendors

We welcome vendors at this trial, but we do ask that you request permission ahead of time. There is no vendor fee, but we request that you donate something to the fundraising effort. If you would like to be a vendor at the trial, please contact the trial chair or the trial secretary. Note that vendors will be outdoors, due to limited space indoors.

There will be a photographer available at the trial.

***** Directions to the show *****

From I-5 North or South. Take the Auburn exit (Highway 18) Exit to Auburn-Black Diamond Road eastbound. Turn right immediately onto SE Green Valley Road (just past Neely Mansion). Go approx 7.5 miles. Turn right onto 212th Avenue SE. After crossing river take first or second left into Argus Ranch.

From I-405 Southbound. Go south on Maple Valley Highway (Highway 169), into Black Diamond. Turn right on Roberts Road (look for Coal Car). Go approximately 4 miles. Turn left onto 218th Street. At the bottom of the long hill is a stop sign. Go straight across the bridge at the Green River and take the first or second left into Argus Ranch.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in

consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
