Entry Information

Entry fee – each run \$ 17.00 (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee for each entry).

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are All American (Mixed Breeds) registered with the Canine Partners Program or dogs with ILP or PAL number, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

A refund of one-half the entry fee will be given for bitches who come in season after entries close, provided the request is made in writing before the commencement of judging each day.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Move-Ups

Move-Ups after entries close must be submitted, in writing, to the Trial Secretary, by 6 pm PDT, September 7, 2009. Saturday/Sunday moveups will be allowed at this trial.

Hospitality Information

Food will be available, for trial workers only, on the grounds. Restaurants are also within quick walking distance.

These trials are LIMITED TO 175 RUNS on Friday with entry method by "first received". The Saturday and Sunday trials are unlimited.. Any entries sent by Fed Ex or special delivery should have the "signature waived" box checked. *No hand-delivered or on-line entries will be accepted for the first 48 hours of the opening.*

Clean Up After Your Dog -- Please keep the park clean and pick up your dog's waste. **No Dogs allowed in restrooms. This is a park policy.**

Equipment for these trials will be provided by Ric Travis – Agility A-Go-Go.

General Show Rules

- The Bell-Vernon Kennel Association assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone, FAX or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
- Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering a dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete. Dogs incorrectly entered may not be transferred to another class after entries close.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.
- Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.
- Deadline for move-ups for Saturday is the Monday preceding the trial. (September 7) Moveups must be submitted in writing (e-mail okay), and must be received by 6 pm, Monday, September 7.
- E-Mail confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the e-mail address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. *If you do not have e-mail or do not regularly check your e-mail, please do **not** include an e-mail address – instead, please indicate that you will need a mailed confirmation. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.* If you have a spam filter, be sure it is set to accept mail from windgold@verizon.net
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Exhibitor Information

- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.*
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- These Agility Trials will be held outdoors on grass. There is plenty of room for shade tents
- We will be running two rings alternately unless we need two judges – then we may be running the rings simultaneously.

Height Cards -- All dogs not having a permanent height card must be measured by the judge of record at the show. If you have a permanent height card, please indicate that on the entry form. Height cards no longer need to be included with the entry. (Yay!)

AGILITY CLASSES

Please see the AKC regulations for agility trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular classes or Preferred classes, with no crossover allowed between them at the same set of trials (weekend.)

Classes offered and limits

This is an unlimited trial. In the event the limits for one judge are exceeded, the overflow will be judged by Bob Kirkbride.

Classes offered include:

- Standard – Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B
- Standard Preferred – Novice, Open, Excellent A & B
- Jumpers with Weaves – Novice A & B, Open, Excellent A & B
- Jumpers with Weaves Preferred – Novice, Open, Excellent A & B
- FAST – Novice A & B, Open and Excellent (offered on Saturday only)
- FAST Preferred – Novice, Open and Excellent (offered on Saturday only)

Height Divisions

Regular classes

- 8 inches - For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
- 12 inches - For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
- 16 inches - For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
- 20 inches - For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
- 24 inches - For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.
- 26 inches – owner's discretion

Preferred Classes:

- 4 Inches: For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.
- 8 Inches: For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.
- 12 Inches: For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.
- 16 Inches: For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
- 20 Inches: For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.

NOTE – Dogs must jump their indicated height in Preferred classes – they do not have the option of jumping at a higher height.

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials.

Prize And Award Information

- First Prize - Blue Rosette and dog toy Second Prize - Red Rosette
- Third Prize - Yellow Rosette Fourth Prize - White Rosette
 - Qualifying Score - Dark Green Rosette

Monetary value of prizes is less than \$5.00 each.

A special rosette will be given for any dog completing a title at this trial. A special rosette and a jump bar will be given for any dog completing a MACH.

Qualifying Score required for all prizes.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above on this entry form.
