**ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS**

"The Mt. Bachelor Kennel Club is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 220 Paper entries: 440 If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

- 1) include postage or be metered;
- 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) **Express mail must be designated "no signature required"**

**AWARDS:** Rosette or Flat Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and ribbons for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

**Regular Classes First Place:** Blue **Second Place:** Red **Third Place:** Yellow **Fourth Place:** White **Qualifying Score:** Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

A MACH Ribbon and MACH Bar will be given for any new MACH dog! Let us know if you are close.

**Sign up for our annual High Scoring Senior Award sponsored by Greg and Glenda Peirce, on Saturday. Over age 65, high combined score with fastest combined YPS (jww and std) as tie breaker. Sign up at the score keepers table to be eligible. Award will be presented Sunday.**

**Oops award—coupons will be given out for each non-qualifying run. Drawing will be held daily for free entry for future trials.**

**There will also be High In Trial awarded for runs on Friday for big, 20-26" and little, 4-16" dogs. Score of 200 with fastest YPS as the tie breaker. Embroidered chair generously donated by anonymous agility lovers of Central Oregon.**

**RING and CRATING INFORMATION**

There is ample space around the rings for crates and shade canopies. There are no trees on-site, so plan to supply your own shade. We've been known to get unpredictable wind gusts. Please stake your canopies securely.

### **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

### **HEIGHT DIVISION**

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judges only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial who do not possess an official height card.

#### **Regular**

8 inches for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers  
 12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers  
 16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers  
 20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers  
 24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers  
 26 inches **Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion**

4" Preferred class  
 8" Preferred class  
 12" Preferred class  
 16" Preferred class  
 20" Preferred class

**OBSTACLES:** Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. *All Days* there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization**.

**CLASSES OFFERED:** All levels of Regular, JWW, & FAST agility, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the **American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390**, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

**PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION:** You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

**JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION:** Please indicate on the entry form if you need to be measured.

**MOVE-UPS:** Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2011**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to [r2agility@frontier.com](mailto:r2agility@frontier.com). No phone move ups accepted. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

**REFUNDS:** A refund 1/2 of the entry amount, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary by **Monday, June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2011**.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS**

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Mt. Bachelor Kennel Club and R2Agility** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

**All dogs** must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

**The safety of dogs is of primary concern.** By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.**

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above on this entry form.
