Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRY INFORMATION: One entry form may be used for all days. An entry form is included in this premium list.

Online entries are not being taken for these trials. Entries can be mailed to the Trial Secretary's address (above) or hand delivered, but no hand delivered entries can be accepted within the first 24 hours after opening.

A refund of entry fees, less judges' fees and secretary fees will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification is provided to the Trial Secretary before the commencement of the trial.

Bitches in season are not allowed on the Trial grounds.

NEW!! EMLKC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries (runs) will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Wednesday, March 2, 2011 at 6:00 PM. Any entries withdrawn, with notification to the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail OK) by **6:00 PM on Monday, March 21, 2011** will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry; otherwise no refund will be given for withdrawn entries, except as specified above for bitches in season. Any wait listed entry that does not get into the trial will receive a full refund.

We will have a white board available for volunteers to sign up. Please consider volunteering to work – even if you are only available to work for one height in a class, that will help the trials run more smoothly!

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular Classes **First Place:** Blue **Second Place:** Red **Third Place:** Yellow **Fourth Place:** White
Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

All dogs completing a MACH or PAX at this trial will receive a MACH/PAX bar and ribbon. If you are close, please let the trial secretary know ahead of time so that we can be ready to celebrate with you!

LOCATION FOR TRIAL: Kenny Ardell Building, Grant County Fairgrounds, Moses Lake, WA

These agility trials will be held indoors on dirt, in 2 rings 100' x 100'. Crating will be available inside the arena, but space will be somewhat limited, so please plan to use space efficiently. X-pens are OK if used to contain multiple dogs. The building has modern restroom facilities.

Snacks and lunch will be provided for workers, and will be available to others for a donation. There are fast food restaurants within a few miles of the show site.

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Standard agility and JWW will be offered each day. FAST classes will be offered on Saturday and Sunday; **NO FAST CLASSES ON FRIDAY**. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s). **If you have questions about which class to enter, please contact the Trial Secretary before the closing date.**

JUDGING SCHEDULE: Judging will begin no earlier than 8:00 AM each day (depending on size of entry; tentatively 9 AM on Friday and Saturday, 8 AM on Sunday). Rings will run alternately on Friday; rings will run concurrently on Saturday and Sunday. A schedule will be sent at the time of final confirmation.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate, provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. **Please designate the dog's breed as "All American" on the entry form.**

HEIGHT DIVISIONS The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process ****PLEASE READ THIS!****

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. **If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running; failure to do so could cause the loss of any Q's earned. If you are not sure whether your dog needs to be measured, please ask the Trial Secretary for assistance when entering. Dan Selthofer is a VMO, so all dogs over age 2 that do not have a permanent height card MUST be measured.**

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted in writing (e-mail is fine) so that the Trial Secretary receives them by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday March 21st, 2011**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send by postal mail, or by email to agimals@juno.com. *If you do not receive a prompt acknowledgement of your move-up request, please contact the Trial Secretary to make sure that it was received.* No phone move ups accepted. Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday move-ups will be accepted at the trial; they must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial is concluded each day.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. **Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement attached, are not acceptable. ALL ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE THE AGREEMENT and MUST BE SIGNED.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee, except for bitches in season as specified on page 2. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging times will be sent to the address given on the AKC entry form after the closing date. **If the exhibitor provides an e-mail address, it is assumed that the exhibitor can receive e-mail with attachments from the Trial Secretary, and confirmation will be sent by e-mail;** please make sure your spam blocker is set to accept messages from agilmals@juno.com and from agilmals@gmail.com. If an e-mail address is not provided, or if postal mail is specifically requested, confirmation of entry will be sent by postal mail. If an exhibitor has not received a confirmation and schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Ephrata-Moses Lake Kennel Club and the Trial Secretary** assume **NO** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS to Grant County Fairgrounds

From I-90 Eastbound: Take I-90 to Exit 176 onto W. Broadway Ave. Go NE on Broadway approx. 2.8 miles to the intersection of W. Broadway and N. Stratford/S. Alder (the street names are different on the left and right side of W. Broadway). Turn left (north) onto N. Stratford and proceed across the bridge to W. Valley Rd and turn left. After passing the fairgrounds on the right, turn right on Airway Drive and continue to the fairgrounds entrance.

From I-90 Westbound: Take I-90 to Exit 179 and exit to Highway 17 North. Follow 17 North around the top of the lake to Grape Dr NE (about 5 miles) and turn left onto Grape Dr NE. Grape Dr. NE is the first major intersection after the Highway 17/N. Stratford intersection. Follow Grape Dr NE south to W. Valley Rd and turn right. After passing the fairgrounds on the right, turn right on Airway Drive and continue to the fairgrounds entrance.

Use the GOLD gate entrance (near the Fair office, on the West side of the Fairgrounds). The gate will open at 2:00 PM on Thursday, March 25th, 2011. It will close at 10:00 PM each day. It will re-open at 6:00 AM each day.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "All American Dog" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
