Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel club or that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Course Familiarization and Warm-ups

Handlers in all classes may walk the course without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

This agility trial will be held outdoors on grass. There will be food available at the agility site. Workers eat for free, all others are asked to give a donation. There is little or no shade at the site area, but plenty of room for shade tents on the premises.

Ring sizes will be 100 x 120.

The Olympic Kennel Club assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The safety of the dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Aggressive dogs will not be allowed.

Important Information for Exhibitors:

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after entries close. (Except for move-up provisions as specified below.)

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Entries which are incorrect, illegible, or incomplete will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Move-ups:

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted, in writing, to the Trial Secretary by 6:00 pm PST, August 15, 2011. E-mail move-ups are acceptable. Move-ups for dogs who complete titles on Saturday and wish to move up on Sunday must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than one-half hour after the completion of judging on Saturday.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of **AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable.**

E-mail entries will not be accepted. If you send an entry in Fed Ex or overnight (Express) mail **PLEASE CHECK the "NO SIGNATURE" box** – I am frequently not home and the post office is closed before I am off work.

We will be accepting entries on a "first received" basis. After the limit has been reached, we will maintain a waiting list until close of entries. Anyone withdrawing before close of entries will receive a full refund.

Entries received before the "official opening date & time" of June 10, 2011, 8:00 a.m. will be returned, as per AKC regulations.

Conformation of Entry:

Conformation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, contact the trial secretary.

I will e-mail conformations after the opening date as the entries are entered in the computer. Final conformations will be sent by e-mail or snail mail as soon as I have completed the running order list. Please note: We will not be doing formal check-in at the show except for those that need to be measured. Exhibitors should check in directly with the gate steward unless your dog needs to be measured. Armband labels will be in a notebook at a CHECK IN TABLE in ALPHABETICAL ORDER (Last Name). If you don't have a height card, your armband label will be with the trial secretary at the score table.

We will be accepting 50% online entries with www.r2agilityonline.com and 50% paper entries. (Entry limits are applicable for the first 48 hours after the trial opens.)

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the "Dogs to be measured" list. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check in.** This will let us know in advance, how many dogs need to be measured so we can plan to allow the time for it.

Directions to the show:

From Seattle: I-5 to Auburn Exit (Highway 18), then 3 – 4 miles to Enumclaw Exit. Take a left at the stoplight. Approximately 15 miles to Enumclaw then follow signs to fairground.

From Tacoma: I-5 North to Auburn Exit. Then same as above.

From Spokane: I-90 West. Out of North Bend will be signs for Auburn (Highway 18 or Tiger Mountain Road.) Stay on highway until Enumclaw Exit. Continue 10 – 15 miles, then follow signs to fairgrounds.
