Directions to Veterinarian: From Argus Ranch – turn right from the Argus driveway, then left on Green Valley Rd. for about 7 miles. Turn left on Auburn-Black Diamond road for about ¼ mile to the entrance to Hwy 18 West. Take Hwy 18 about 1.5 miles to the Auburn Way exit. Take a left at Auburn Way and drive for about 2 blocks to clinic.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

NOTE: Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

- One half of Entry fees, will be refunded for bitches who come in season, provided notification is given to the Trial Secretary prior to the day of trial. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds.

Move-Ups after entries close must be submitted, in writing, to the Trial secretary by 6:00 pm Monday, April 4, 2011. Dog's registered name & call name, breed, AKC reg. #, title completed and date, class currently entered, new class requested, owner's name and date. E-mail move-ups will only be official after e-mail confirmation of move-up is sent.

Move-ups for the trial will be allowed provided the above information is given to the secretary before the close of each day's trial.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after entries close. (Except for move-up provisions as specified above.)

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Entries which are incorrect, illegible, or incomplete will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules attached, are not acceptable. E-mail entries will not be accepted. If you send an entry in Fed X or overnight mail, **PLEASE check the "NO SIGNATURE" box.** Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form (e-mail or snail mail) after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

Entry Fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee.

Height Divisions: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Dogs with AKC height cards will not need to be measured if the card is presented at the time of measuring.

From I-5 North or South: Take the Auburn exit (Hwy 18). Exit to Auburn-Black Diamond Rd. Eastbound. Turn right immediately onto SE Green Valley Rd. (just Past Neely Mansion). Go Approx. 7.5 miles. Turn right onto 212th Ave. SE. After crossing river, take first left into Argus Ranch.

From I-405 Southbound: Go south on Maple Valley Hwy (Hwy 169), into Black Diamond. Turn right on Roberts Rd. (look for Coal Car). Go approx. 4 miles. Turn left onto 218th St. At the bottom of the long hill is a stop sign. Go straight across the bridge at the Green River And take the first or second left into Argus Ranch.

Crating:

Crating is very tight in the indoor arena area. Please try and keep spacing close. Please do not use exercise pens inside the building.

Mixed breed classes may be offered at all-breed AKC agility trials and/or all-breed conformation/obedience trials that hold agility with them.
