ENTRY INFORMATION: One entry form may be used for all days

Entry Fee: \$20.00 first entry (includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee) and \$12.00 2nd & 3rd regular entry, same dog same day (includes \$3 AKC recording fee)

Dogs eligible to enter: This Trial is open to all dogs 15 months or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained ILP/PAL numbers or AKC Canine Partners listing numbers from AKC or approved FSS breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Catalog: \$10.00 Please pre-order catalogs using check box on entry form. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the show.

Closing Date: 6:00 PM Wednesday Sept. 28th, 2011

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and ribbons for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular Classes First Place: Blue **Second Place:** Red **Third Place:** Yellow **Fourth Place:** White **Qualifying Score:** Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

A MACH / PAX Ribbon and a MACH / PAX Bar will be given for any new MACH / PAX dog! Please let me know before the trial if you are close.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, Oct. 10th, 2011.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to arrmet@aol.com. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

REFUNDS: A refund of one-half the entry fees will be given for any bitch that comes into season after the close of entries, provided that the trial secretary is notified before the commencement of judging each day. Except for the above, there shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

Bitches in season are not allowed in the Agility Trial area.

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: There is a new section at top of entry form to designate if your dog has a valid height card or if it needs to be measured. All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge, except 24"/26", Kitty Bradley is a VMO. Allow plenty of time to be measured. Height divisions are as follows:

Regular

8 inches for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
 12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
 16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
 20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
 24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers
 26 inches at owner's option

Preferred

4 inches
 8 inches
 12 inches
 16 inches
 20 inches

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Weave poles will have 24" spacing (center to center).

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Standard, Jumpers, and FAST, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es). **You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).**

RING and CRATING INFORMATION

There is ample space for crating around the rings. There is very limited shade, so plan accordingly.

FOOD INFORMATION

There are fast food locations and grocery stores in Wenatchee within a few blocks of the show site.

Driving Directions to Confluence State Park, 333 Olds Station Rd., Wenatchee, WA 98801

From West Hwy 97 and 2: Exit the Highway at Easy Street. Turn right onto Easy Street and drive about ¼ mile to Penny Rd. Turn left onto Penny Rd and drive to Euclid Ave. Turn right onto Euclid and follow around to Olds Station Rd. The park entrance and sign will be on your left.

From East Hwy 97 and 2: Exit the Highway at Euclid Ave (follow State Park Signs). Turn left at the exit onto Euclid Ave. Follow it to Olds Station Rd and to the state park signs and entrance.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached, are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Wenatchee Kennel Club** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. **Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.**

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all breed ADC agility trials at the clubs option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the AKC (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
