OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

CLASSES OFFERED: All levels of Regular and JWW agility, including the Preferred Classes will be offered. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION: You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please include a copy of your jump height card with your entry. All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge, except 24"/26", unless a VMO or REP is present.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, **without the agreement attached are not acceptable.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **WSOTC** assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. **WSOTC** does not agree to arbitration.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

WSOTC HAS DESIGNATED THE "SHOW GROUNDS" TO INCLUDE ARGUS RANCH FACILITY FOR DOGS' ENTIRE FACILITY, BUT DOES NOT INCLUDE THE PUBLIC OFF-LEASH DOG PARK JUST BEHIND THE SHOW AREA.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This Trial is open to all dogs over the age of **15 months** that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained ILP or PAL numbers from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, July 7th, 2008.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to my3sams@comcast.net. **NO PHONE MOVE UPS ACCEPTED.**

REFUNDS: A refund of the entry amount, less fees of \$10, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at noon Friday, July 11th, 2008 (**or when RINGS ARE SET UP AND READY.**)

THERE SHALL BE NO DRILLING NOR INTENSIVE OR CORRECTIVE TRAINING OF DOGS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR PREMISES.

ALL DOGS shall be kept on leash except when in the agility rings.

• **ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS** If you include an email address on your entry form, your confirmations will be sent via email only. We will send out a preliminary confirmation shortly after we receive your entry and a final confirmation after closing. Please check ALL information – including addresses, dog's numbers, and classes entered.

• **SITE & CRATING INFORMATION** WE WILL BE RUNNING TWO RINGS simultaneously, depending on numbers and ring crew availability in order to finish the trial in a timely manner. The trial will be run outdoors on grass. There is plenty of crating space and room for Shade Tents around rings.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes and the FAST titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
